FIR regarding assault, threat to death, criminal intimidation (non-bailable), obscene abuse, outraging the modesty of a woman, drunken driving, rash and dangerous driving and public nuisance on 29.12.2025

Sir,

I, Sandeep Kumar Saha, aged about 37 years, presently posted as Inspector, Central Goods & Services Tax & Central Excise (CGST & CX), Siliguri, do hereby submit the following facts for registration of an FIR and for taking necessary legal action against the accused persons:

Facts of the Case:

1. That on 29.12.2025, between 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM, I along with my wife Smt. Dipannita Das and my 4-year-old son was returning by my private car from Gajoldoba, Junglee Mohal Park.
2. When my vehicle reached near Bhabesh More Petrol Pump, Siliguri, one three-wheeler (TREGO) bearing Registration No. WB-71-C-0197, carrying one driver and three passengers, came from behind and forcefully hit the side glass of my car due to rash and negligent driving.
3. Immediately thereafter, the driver and the passengers started using filthy, obscene and abusive language, directed towards me and my wife, falsely alleging that I had not given a left indicator, though the same was duly indicated.
4. The said three-wheeler then proceeded towards NJP via Bhabesh More. In order to prevent further danger and to seek accountability, I followed the vehicle.
5. During the course of events, the accused persons intentionally stopped my vehicle, whereupon the driver pushed me, assaulted me physically and further passed highly vulgar and obscene remarks against my wife, thereby outraging her modesty in a public place, causing grave mental trauma to my family including my minor son.
6. At that time, the accused driver also openly threatened me with death, stating in substance that he would kill me, and that no one, including the police, could save me, thereby causing serious fear for my life and the safety of my family.

7. I again followed the accused persons and intercepted the vehicle near a roadside meat shop, where further verbal altercation occurred. At that time, it was clearly evident that the driver and his associates were heavily intoxicated with alcohol and were driving the vehicle under the influence of alcohol, thereby endangering public safety.
8. I noted down the vehicle number WB-71-C-0197 and disclosed my identity by showing my official government identity card, but the accused driver arrogantly stated that he did not care and claimed that "all police are in his pocket", further criminally intimidating me and reinforcing the threat to my life.
9. The associates of the driver supported him and collectively threatened, abused and intimidated me, causing public nuisance and breach of peace.
10. Upon enquiry, the registered owner of the offending vehicle was found to be:
 - Name: Khagen Das
 - S/o: Late Nagen Das
 - Mobile No.: 9832411740
 - Address: Debashis Colony, South Bharat Nagar, Siliguri
11. On contacting the said owner on 29.12.2025, he admitted ownership of the vehicle and stated that he had handed over the vehicle to one BUA, C/o Balai Saha, Mobile No. 9749307230, who is residing in the nearby locality of the owner's residence at Debashis Colony, South Bharat Nagar, Siliguri.

Offences Committed:

The accused persons have committed cognizable offences punishable under the following provisions of law:

Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS):

- Section 115(2) – Voluntarily causing hurt
- Section 118 – Voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous conduct
- Section 131 – Assault or criminal force
- Section 74 – Sexual harassment / obscene acts and remarks
- Section 79 – Word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman
- Section 351(4) – Criminal intimidation by threat to death (NON-BAILABLE)
- Section 352 – Intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of peace
- Section 291 – Public nuisance
- Section 125 – Act endangering life or personal safety of others

Motor Vehicles Act, 1988:

- Section 184 – Driving dangerously
- Section 185 – Driving by a drunken person or by a person under the influence of alcohol

- Section 177 – General provision for punishment
- Section 181 – Driving without valid licence (*subject to verification*)
- Section 202 – Power to arrest without warrant (*as applicable*)

Prayer:

In view of the above facts and circumstances, I most respectfully request you to:

1. Register an FIR immediately, including Section 351(4) BNS (non-bailable).
2. Arrest the accused persons and conduct medical examination to establish intoxication.
3. Seize the offending vehicle bearing Registration No. WB-71-C-0197.
4. Take strict legal action to ensure safety of women, children and law-abiding citizens.
