In producing herewith, the arrested One (01) accused persons namely K. Perumal (37/M) SO- Late Gobinda Swami of Chitton PS- Chitton, Dist- Chitton, Andra Pradesh (Not verified) along with the following seized articles under proper seizure list: -

Total 120(Twelve) numbers of plastic packets and 03(Three) white plastic boras containing Total 196.640 Kg (One HundredNinety SixKilograms and six Hundred and Forty Grams) Approx suspect to be Ganja along with Ashok Leland 10-wheeler Truck bearing Registration Number TN-02T-1398 Marked as follows :-

- (i) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.305 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Cellotape marked as Exhibit-"A".

I, SI Samik Paul of New Jalpaiguri Police station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint against above noted one (01) arrested accused persons to the effect that today 31.12.2025 at about 13.35 hrs I received a specific source input that One truck bearing registration no- TN-02T-1398 coming from Dinhata, Cooch Bihar and heading towards Bihar with huge quantity of Ganja for delivering the same to their designed customers. The matter was diarized vide NJP PS PS GDE No.1483 Dt. 31.12.2025 and I informed the matter to SI Partha Sarathi Das, Officer-In-Charge, New Jalpaiguri Police Station in writing a letter to him and expressed the entire information. As per his kind direction myself along with other officers and force named SI Tanmoy, ASI Nilam Swarnakar, C/ 1458 Sajan Tamang, C/453- Uttam Dey, VP/i3 Jamirul Islam,



information in hand vide NJP PS GDE No 1484 dated 31.12.2025 and M.C.C. No. 676 dated 31.12.2025. In the meantime, I also informed through writing to the Videographer namely Tapan Mandal SO- Late Tusta Mandal of SS Colony, Block-E, W/No-34, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri to be present at Canal Road, Chobavitta, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri to video graph the Video of whole process of search and seizure if any. Under these circumstances any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidences of facility for the escape of the offender. At about 14.15 hrs we arrived at Canal Road, Chobavitta, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and on the way to the spot, I managed two independent witnesses namely i) Firoj Rahaman (37) SO- Ajijul Rahaman of Amaidighi PS-NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri & ii) Subal Roy (55) SO- Late Seben Roy of Chobavitta, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri and disclosed our identity and informed them about the information in hand and requested them to accompany us and remain present in the whole process during search and seizure if necessary with a written letter and necessary permission of their presence and act as witnesses under relevant provision of law. After arrival at the spot and as per identified by the source we intercepted one vehicle bearing registration no- TN-02T-1398 with 01 (One) person inside the vehicle which was matched with our information. Accordingly, we intercepted the vehicle and apprehended the 01 (One) accused person who disclosed their identity as noted above.

After disclosing our identity, we detained the above noted accused person for a strong reason to believe that he is illegally possessing Ganja in their vehicle bearing No TN-02T-1398 which he is carrying for clandestine disposal. On being asked he confessed that he is possessed Ganja in the separate chamber behind the driver seat and adjacent seat. I then gave him option in writing whether he wanted to be searched in presence of Executive Magistrate or by any Police Gazetted Officer. Then they agreed to be searched by any one of them. Further, I served him a notice in accordance with provisions of law in this regard. I also offered the independent witnesses and the apprehended persons to search our Police Party as per provision of law but the independent witnesses searched the police party but found nothing apart from their mobile phones and other gadgets. Accordingly, I informed the matter to the Officer-In-Charge, NJP PS and as per his kind order I informed the fact to Shri Robin Thapa, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East-II, Siliguri Police Commissionerate through writing detailed for acting as Special Executive Magistrate, of SPC for the day regarding the interception of the vehicle and the person suspected to be possessed of Ganja and requested him to come to the spot and to supervise the search and seizure being a gazette officer. Accordingly at 14.50 hrs Shri Robin Thapa, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East-II, Siliguri Police Commissionerate arrived at the spot and accordingly, I disclosed his identity to the detained persons as Special Executive Magistrate of Siliguri Police Commissionerate. Then the 02 (Two) independent witnesses search Shri Robin Thapa in presence of the detained person and found nothing from his possession.

Then in presence of Shri Robin Thapa, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East-II, Siliguri Police Commissionerate and two independent public witnesses I along with the team searched the vehicle bearing registration no- TN-02T-1398 following all formalities and recovered 12 no's of plastic packets and 03 no's of white plastic boras containing of suspect to be Ganja from the separate chamber in back side of the driver and adjacent seat. On demand in presence of the Shri Robin Thapa, ACP, East-II, SPC he failed to produce any valid document in support of possessing of the Ganja he is carrying in the vehicle bearing registration no- TN-02T-1398. Thereafter, I weighted 12 no's of plastic packets and 03 no's white boras containing said to be Ganja in presence of Shri Robin Thapa and the independent witnesses with the weighing instrument and found total 196.640 Kg (One Hundred Ninety Six Kilograms and six Hundred and Forty Grams) Approx suspect to be Ganja which are as follows- i) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.305 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit- "A". ii) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.230 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"B". iii) One Plastic packet containing approx..12.070 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit- "C". iv) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.190 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"D". v)One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.225 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"E". vi)One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.375 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"F".vii) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.200 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit- "G".viii) One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.280 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"H". ix)One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.360 Kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"I". x)One Plastic packet containing approx. 12.360 kgs of suspect to be Ganja wrapped with brown colour Sellotape marked as Exhibit-"J".xi) One

Accordingly I seized the above noted articles from the exclusive possession of the above noted 01 (One) accused person at the spot i.e. at Canal Road, Chobavitta, PS- NJP, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper seizure list in presence of Shri Robin Thapa, ACP, East II, SPCas well as independent witnesses as noted above and acknowledged by the accused person and marked as Exhibit "A", Exhibit "B", Exhibit "C", Exhibit "D", Exhibit "E", Exhibit "F". Subsequently, I labelled the seized articles in presence Shri Robin Thapa, ACP, East-II, SPC and independent witnesses and accused persons as noted above. The whole process of seizure, sealed and labelled was made in between 15.10 Hrs to 16.35 Hrs on 31.12.2025. On further asked the above noted person confessed in presence of Shri Robin Thapa, ACP, East-II, SPCand other witnesses that he procured the Ganja clandestinely from Dinjata for the purpose of supply the same to their designed customers at Bihar area as per their requirement for their personal gain by illegal means. On interrogation he also disclosed that he has been dealing in such business of selling the Ganja illegally for last few months.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles it is quite evident that the accused person namely i)K. Perumal (37/M) SO- Late Gobinda Swami of Chitton PS- Chitton, Dist- Chitton, Andra Pradesh (Not verified) is involved in procuring and selling of Ganja illegally and contravening the norms of NDPS Act was established, Then, I arrested the above noted accused persons after observing all guidelines of Apex court of arrest as well as after disclosing the ground of arrest and issued necessary Memo of Arrest. The arrest was made in 15.40 hrs.

Under the above noted facts and circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case under proper sections of law may kindly be started against the above noted arrested accused persons namely i)K. Perumal (37/M) SO- Late Gobinda Swami of Chitton PS- Chitton, Dist- Chitton, Andra Pradesh (Not verified) and arrange for its investigation.
