Subject: Complaint/FIR regarding Suspicious and unnatural death of my sister Late Gopa Sarkar.

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Debabrata Guha, hereby submit this written complaint and request registration of an FIR regarding the suspicious and unnatural death of my sister, Late Gopa Sarkar.

Today morning at around 5:30 AM, my nephew Soumyadeep Sarkar informed me that his mother and my sister Gopa Sarkar had passed away last night on 21st December 2025, allegedly due to cardiac arrest at her house Hakimpara, W/No.15, P.S- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling. This information came as a complete shock to me.

I wish to bring to your notice that no one informed me or any other relatives about her demise at the time it occurred. I further came to know that the cremation was carried out hastily without informing me or any of the relatives, and I only got to know about her death shortly after 5:30 AM, by which time the cremation had already been completed. This secrecy and undue haste in conducting the last rites has raised serious suspicion in my mind.

As per my understanding, this death does not appear to be a natural collapse. I strongly suspect foul play, as no post-mortem examination was demanded or conducted by the doctor before issuing the death certificate, and the cremation was done immediately. This appears to have been deliberately done to avoid exposure of facts through a post mortem examination.

My sister was physically fit, mentally alert, and was talking normally the night before her death. There were no known medical conditions or complaints that could justify a sudden cardiac arrest under such circumstances.

I strongly suspect that the death of my sister is unnatural and suspicious. I also suspect the possible involvement of the following persons:

1. Soumyadeep Sarkar S/O- Lt. Bimalangshu Sarkar.
2. Samriddha Saha (girlfriend)
3. Gouri Goswami W/O- Sadhan Goswami
4. Sadhan Goswami (girlfriend's grandfather)

I also trust that the above noted persons have killed my sister, Late Gopa Sarkar.
