Sir

In producing herewith following three accused namely 1) Santosh Kumar (23 years) S/O Badri Sah of Ratania, PO Chamarua, PS Panapur, Dist Muzaffarpur, Bihar (Not Verified), 2) Kundan Kumar Choudhury (35 years) S/O Ram Naresh Choudhury of Kharana Jay Ram, PO Kharana Dhi, PS Khurani, Dist Muzaffarpur, Bihar (Not Verified), 3) Birendar Kumar (33 years) S/O Lt Laxman Sah of Gangapur, PO Bisandarpur, PS Kati, Dist Muzaffarpur, Bihar (Not Verified), 4) Uttam Sutradhar (31 years) S/O Lt Gopal Sutradhar, of Dasrath pally, ward no 44, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri with following seized articles viz:

- i) One iron made Hacksaw blade.
- ii) One yellow colour iron made hammer.
- iii) One iron made 18 inches iron rod.
- iv) One iron made screw driver length approx 12 inches.
- v) One gray colour Tata punch vehicle bearing registration no BR 01 JB 5095

I, SI Youel Lepcha, S/o Jai Tshering Lepcha, of Bhaktinagar Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this complaint against the above-noted accused persons and 7-8 others to the effect that today, on 07.01.2026, at about 00:05 hours, I received specific source information that 11-12 miscreants had assembled at Salugara Bazar opposite of Nava Flower mill, NH 10 under Bhaktinagar PS, beside which one Tata Punch car was parked, and that they were in possession of deadly weapons and were making preparation to commit dacoity in the Salugara area. Accordingly, I informed the matter to the inspector incharge, Bhaktinagar Police Station, and diarised the fact in the General Diary vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No. 266/26 dated 07.01.2026. As per orders, I along with SI Srimanta Chatterjee, ASI Dipak Karmakar, and C/374 Debraj Biswas of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC, proceeded to Salugara Bazar under Bhaktinagar Police Station, District Jalpaiguri, to work out the information. At about 00:35 hours, we reached Salugara Bazar opposite of Nava Flower mill, NH 10 under Bhaktinagar PS and, as indicated by the source, noticed that 7/8 persons were assembled there and one four wheeler was parked besides them whispering among themselves in very low voices. Accordingly, we cordoned off the area properly and approached them slowly and cautiously. On noticing the police party, they started shouting "police, police" repeatedly and attempted to flee from the spot.

After a hot chase, we managed to apprehend the tata punch vehicle bearing registration No. BR-01-JB-5095 in which four individuals were seated at the time. However, 7-8 other persons managed to flee from the spot by taking advantage of darkness and the open area.

On interrogation, the apprehended accused persons disclosed their names and identities as noted above and stated that they were making preparation to commit dacoity in the Salugara area. On search, the above-noted weapons of offence were recovered from their conscious possessions which were kept in a boot of the vehicle. On demand, they failed to produce any valid documents in respect of the Tata Punch car.

On further interrogation, the accused persons gave contradictory statements at different times and failed to give any satisfactory explanation for their presence at the spot with deadly weapons during late night hours.

Accordingly, I seized the above-noted car and weapons of offence from their exclusive and conscious possession under proper seizure list in the presence of witnesses, duly acknowledged by the accused persons, and subsequently arrested them under proper arrest memo after observing all legal formalities. The search and seizure were conducted on 07.01.2026 between 00:55 hours and 01:25 hours, and the entire procedure was documented through proper audio-visual means.

Under the above noted fact and circumstance, I, therefore pray to you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the above noted 04 (four) arrested accused persons namely 1) Santosh Kumar, 2) Kundan Kumar Choudhury (35 years) S/O Ram Naresh Choudhury of Kharana Jay Ram, PO Kharana Dhi, 3) Birendar Kumar, 4) Uttam Sutradhar and others kindly arrange for its investigation


