Sub: Complaint against Siyon Shrestha and others in connection with the incident dated 24.09.2025 and request for registration of FIR pursuant to Court's Order dated 11.12.2025 Passed by the Ld. A.C.J.M Court Siliguri.

I, Siddharth Bhattacharya, son of Late Chandidas Bhattacharya, resident of Shivmandir, Bairatal, Vivekananda Road, Halermatha, P.S. Matigara, District- Darjeeling, West-Bengal, Pin- 734011, most respectfully beg to state as follows:

1. That on 24.09.2025, the accused person Siyon Shrestha, along with 10-15 other antisocial miscreants, came on bikes and scooties, some of whose vehicle numbers are WB-74-AZ-7986, WB-74-BG-7753, WB-74-BN-6467 and WB-74-BE-4397, and attacked me with malicious intention. They chased me from "TCP More" up to "New Champta Mayfair Tea Factory" and brutally assaulted me with iron rods, knuckles, and bike chains. They also snatched my wallet, gold chain, and the key of my motorcycle bearing registration no. WB-74-BH-6679.

2. That I cried for help, but they paid no heed and continued the assault, causing me severe bodily injuries.

3. That I somehow managed to escape and took shelter at a nearby tea factory labourer's residence. From there, I was rescued by Matigara Police and taken to the Matigara Police Station, where I narrated the entire incident. The police subsequently helped in recovering my motorcycle, but my other snatched articles have not yet been returned by the accused persons.

4. That due to the barbaric assault, I had to undergo medical treatment and was advised complete bed rest. After recovering, I approached Matigara Police Station to lodge an FIR, but though my complaint was received, no specific case was registered.
5. That thereafter, I lodged a complaint before the Commissioner of Police on 30.10.2025, but despite receipt of the same, no case was initiated. Being left with no alternative, I filed Misc. Petition Case No. 93 of 2025 on 20.11.2025 before the Learned A.C.J.M., Siliguri under Section 175(3) of the B.N.S.S.
6. That on 11.12.2025, the Learned Court was pleased to pass an order directing as follows:  
*"Issue necessary direction to the Inspector-in-Charge, Matigara Police Station, to register the complaint afresh."*

In view of the above, I most respectfully request your good office to kindly comply with the order dated 11.12.2025 passed by the Learned A.C.J.M., Siliguri, and register my complaint/FIR at the earliest and take necessary action in accordance with law.

I shall remain obliged for your kind cooperation.
