on 3rd of Jan 2026 my husband and I came to Siliguri to visit my ailing
brother-in-law who was admitted at N.B.M.C.H. During this visit I was
staying at my niece house (Rented) add:- Chota Pathuram Road, Thikrikatta
(Tappu & Pappu House) and I gave all my jewellery to my niece for
safekeeping but on 8th of Jan 2026 when I returned to my niece's rented
house after coming from Darjeeling where I went on 7th of Jan 2026, I
noticed that all my jewellery including my niece's jewellery have been
stolen from the almshouse of my niece's rented house. I also found
that my bill papers of that Jewellery are also stolen from that
almshouse.
