Sir,

On 03.01.2026, during night vehicle patrolling duty on NH-327 and Asian Highway-2, under the command of the undersigned and accompanied by 03 other officials, a DCM vehicle bearing Registration No. AS-01-RC-7555, which was proceeding at high speed towards Siliguri, was signalled to stop on suspicion.

However, the vehicle did not stop and was chased. After the vehicle was finally stopped at the roadside, the driver suddenly jumped out and fled from the spot, taking advantage of darkness and confusion. Upon conducting a search of the vehicle, two persons along with 23 Nos of buffaloes (Pada) were found inside the DCM (Vehicle) Registration No. AS-01-RC-7555. On questioning, the persons disclosed their identities as follows:


1. Moynal Uddin Sheikh, aged 31 years, S/o Hojrot Ali Sheikh, Resident of Shimultapur No-3, P.S. Gossaigaon, Sub-Division Gossaigaon, District Kokrajhar, Assam-783361.
2. Azijul Sheikh, aged 25 years, S/o Anwar Ali, Resident of Village Pastibari, P.S. Kazigaon, Sub-Division Parbat Jhora, District Dhubri, Assam-783334.

On being asked about the contents of the vehicle, they stated that they were transporting the buffaloes (Pada) from an unknown place in India to Srirampur, Assam. When asked to produce valid ownership or transportation documents for the animals, they failed to produce any such documents. Further, they stated that the cattle belonged to one Kadir, Mobile No. 7479134111, Resident of Kestopur, West Bengal and that they were transporting the same to Assam on his instructions for a consideration of ₹5,000. On further questioning, they revealed that the cattle were being transported illegally, in violation of prevailing laws and in a manner causing unnecessary cruelty to animals. Accordingly, the buffaloes (Pada) along with the DCM vehicle were seized as per law, and the above-named persons were apprehended and detained.

In view of the above facts, arrest memos were served upon both the accused persons, and they are being forwarded to Bagdogra Police Station on 04.01.2026 at 04.35 hrs for further necessary legal action along with proper documentation.


