I, SI Biswajit Ghosh of DD, SPC, Siliguri would like to inform you that today on 06.01.2026 at 13.45 hrs received a source information that one White coloured Maruti Wagon R vehicle bearing No. WB 69 C / 5655 is suspiciously parked inside Singhijhora Tea Estate, Division No. 6 under Bagdogra PS and suspecting to be loaded with huge quantity of packets of Ganja.

Accordingly, I diarized the information vide DD,SPC GDE No. 23 Dated 06.01.2026 and informed ACP, DD, SPC. As per direction of ACP DD SPC, Siliguri, myself along with SI Sk Tamzid Ali, SI Ganesh Roy, ASI Sushanta Dey, Const. 686 Arup Saha, Const. 562 Utpal Saha left for Singhijhora Tea Estate, Division No. 6 under Bagdogra PS, Dist-Darjeeling vide DD,SPC GDE No 24 dated 06.01.2026 and CC No 02/26 dated 06.01.2026 to work out the information. At the time of departure from the office, I took white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, official stamp, stamp pad, weighing machine and other necessary requirements. On the way to the spot, I also requested two independent witnesses namely (1) Md. Ramjan(M/26) S/O Late Md Fakira of Promod Nagar, PS-Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and (2) Barun Roy (M/20) S/O Late Ram Sagarath Roy of Singhijhora T.E, Baro Line, PS- Bagdorga, Dist- Darjeeling in writing to remain as witness during search and seizure and accordingly they gave their consent.

At about 14.25 hrs, we arrived at Singhijhora Tea Estate, Division No. 6 and as indicated by the source and in presence of witnesses we found that one White coloured Maruti Wagon R vehicle bearing No. WB 69 C / 5655 is suspiciously parked inside Singhijhora Tea Estate, Division No. 6 under Bagdogra PS in abandoned condition. We found that the vehicle is loaded with huge quantity of packets wrapped with brown coloured plastic and smell of Ganja is coming out from those packets. Accordingly, I informed the matter ACP DD, SPC and as per his direction, informed Sri Kajal Sarkar, Inspector of Police, DD, SPC regarding the information and requested him to come at Singhijhora Tea Estate, Division No. 6 near Railway Track under Bagdogra PS to remain present and to supervise the search and seizure.

Accordingly at 15.00 hrs Sri Kajal Sarkar, Inspector of Police, DD, SPC arrived at the spot and subsequently, under his supervision, in presence of witnesses the process of search of the recovered White coloured Maruti Wagon R vehicle bearing No. WB 69 C / 5655 was conducted following all formalities and recovered total 10 (ten) packets of seems to be Ganja from the inside of the vehicle.

Thereafter, I weighted the recovered ten packets with the weighing instrument and found 1) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-A, (2) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.150 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-B (3) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-C (4) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-D (5) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-E (6) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-F (7) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.100 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-G (8) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-H (9) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 11.200 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-I (10) One packet wrapped with Brown Coloured plastic containing 5.100 Kg seems to be Ganja, marked as Exhibit-J (total 105.750 Kgs) which I, seized, sealed and labelled. I also seized White coloured Maruti Wagon R vehicle bearing No. WB 69 C / 5655 at the spot. I seized the articles under proper seizure list under videography and duly signed by above noted witnesses and the Gazetted officer. The whole process of seizure was made in between 15.05 hrs and 15.55 hrs on 06.01.2026

From the above noted facts and seizure of contraband narcotic substance , it is quite evident that the driver / owner of the seized vehicle and others are involve in procuring and selling of Ganja illegally contravening the norms of NDPS Act and due to some reasons the driver / owner of the seized vehicle parked the vehicle inside the tea garden and fled away from the spot.

Under the above circumstances, I pray to you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the driver / owner of the seized vehicle bearing No. WB 69 C / 5655 and others and arrange for its investigation.
