Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Narayan Upadhyaya, resident of Sayapatri II Apartments
Sisabari, Milan More, Darjelling, West Bengal would like
to bring the following incident to your kind notice:

On 10th Jan 2026 at around 7:00pm at Maheswari More
Milan more main road, my wife suffered ~~acc~~ was
crossing the road, a motor cycle being driven at a very
high and reckless speed came from behind and hit
her. Due to the impact, she fell down severely.

As a result of this accident, my wife suffered a
complete fracture in her right leg and a serious
dislocation of her left shoulder. She sustained
grievous injuries and is currently admitted to
Mohpal ortho centre, Pradhman Nagar, where she
is undergoing medical treatment.

The rider was driving the motorcycle in a rash and
negligent manner, which directly caused this serious
accident. I request you to kindly register an FIR
in this matter and take necessary legal action
against the rider as per law.

I am ready to cooperate fully with the investigation
and provide any additional information required.
