Sub: Complaint regarding violation of Government Order and illegal transportation of riverbed materials by overloaded vehicle

Sir,

I respectfully submit that I, **S.I. Kamal Biswas of Gajoldoba Out Post under Bhorer Alo Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate**, am lodging this written complaint against the below-named accused person for violation of Government Order and illegal transportation of riverbed materials by an overloaded vehicle.

That on **09.01.2026 at about 21:55 hrs**, I, along with **C/959 Dijen Chandra Roy** and **CV/334 Sukhen Biswas**, while performing **Night Naka duty at Teesta Barrage**, under Bhorer Alo Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, vide **MCC No. 48/26 corresponding to Gajoldoba OP GDE No. 201 dated 09.01.2026**, received reliable information that an overloaded vehicle carrying riverbed materials illegally was proceeding towards Siliguri via **Teesta Barrage Bridge**. Accordingly, I informed the matter to you and, as per your kind direction, I, along with the force, rushed to the spot, i.e., **Teesta Barrage Bridge**, and intercepted one **12-wheeler Tata Signa Truck bearing Registration No. WB-73-H-6999**, with "Nur Express" written on its windshield. The driver, on interrogation, disclosed his identity as **Suyel Hoque (M/27 years)**, S/o Rafikul Islam, of Jogesh Chandra Tea Garden, P.S. Malbazar, District Jalpaiguri, West Bengal.

On demand, the driver failed to produce any valid documents such as royalty challan, permit, or authorization in respect of the transported riverbed materials. During enquiry, it was revealed that the said riverbed materials had been **illegally loaded from the Gheesh River bank under Malbazar Police Station jurisdiction**.

Further, it is pertinent to mention that the **Teesta Barrage Bridge** is governed by **Government Order vide Memo No. 275/1(2) dated 10.12.2025**, issued by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Teesta Barrage Sub-Division No. IV, Gajoldoba, wherein the **permissible load limit for vehicles has been restricted to 25 tonnes**. In gross violation of the said Government Order, the intercepted vehicle was weighed, and the **gross vehicle weight was found to be 56,360 kg**, which is far beyond the permitted limit.

Thus, the accused driver knowingly **disobeyed a lawful order promulgated by a public servant**, endangered public safety, and caused potential risk to a vital government infrastructure, besides being involved in illegal extraction and transportation of riverbed materials for wrongful gain, resulting in substantial revenue loss to the Government.

Hence, I seized the above-mentioned truck along with the riverbed materials under a proper seizure list and arrested the accused driver, **Suyel Hoque**, under proper arrest memo. The seizure and arrest were effected between **04:10 hrs and 04:20 hrs on 10.01.2026**.

Under the above circumstances, I humbly pray that a **specific case** may kindly be registered against the accused person under appropriate sections of law and necessary investigation be taken up.
