Subject: Illegal demolition of business structure, criminal trespass, wrongful confinement, and continued harassment
REF gd no. 85

Respected Sir,

I, Amrit Thapa, aged 55+ years, resident of Matigara Bazaar Siliguri, humbly request your urgent intervention in an extremely serious and illegal act committed against me and my family, causing heavy financial and mental harm.

1. Background of Property & Business

-The piece of land located at Matigara bazaar plot no.LR 26 DI fund land Khatian No.2 Mouza MATIGARA is in possession of DI fund in and has been in the possession and use of my family for many years. On this plot, I have been running my legitimate business: AMRIT TRADING since 30+ years, which is my primary source of livelihood and income.

2. Previous Criminal Incident & Complaint Already Filed

-On previous 02/11/2026 certain individuals Sent By Bikram Thapa (alias sharma) illegally encroached upon my property by constructing a boundary wall without any authority or court order. I immediately lodged a written complaint at Matigara Police Station and the matter was diarized under GD/Receiving No. 85 dated 02/11/2026. I am attaching a photocopy of the said receiving for ready reference.

Despite informing the police at that time, the accused persons have continued their harassment and work. I have been informed that the accused submitted Khazana documents few months ago to claim ownership. I respectfully state that Khazana (Revenue Payment) is not a title deed, nor does it confer ownership or transfer of title.

It merely reflects land revenue/payment records, not legal possession or ownership.

The accused is misrepresenting a Khazana as ownership deed and using it to justify illegal actions.

If the matter truly involves ownership, then only a Court of Law has the authority to decide and direct any party to vacate or demolish.

I am fully willing to comply with the Court's directions if and when issued, but the accused has taken the law into his own hands without any Court Order, without any eviction order, and without police supervision which is completely unlawful. And illegal activities without any fear of law.

3. Illegal Midnight Demolition on (Date & Time)

On 11/01/2026 at around approximately 12:00 AM midnight, Mona Biswas, Bikram Thapa S/O OF Shyam Thapa accompanied by JCP personnel and family members recognised as Preksha Thapa, Pampha Thapa and Chumki (as seen at the site) came to my property and illegally demolished my entire business structure, breaking it into pieces. This was done:

Without any prior notice,

Without any legal demolition order,

Without any presence of municipal staff, surveyor, or magistrate,

And clearly to cause wrongful loss to me.

My entire shop, equipment, materials, and business infrastructure have been reduced to bits and pieces, causing financial loss running into lakhs of rupees and destroying my livelihood overnight.

4. Wrongful Confinement Used Against Me

-When I witnessed the unlawful activity from inside my residence, I attempted to come out. Shockingly, I found that the shutter of my residence was locked from outside using an external hanging lock, preventing me from stepping out.

This act amounts to criminal wrongful confinement under Section 340/342 IPC.

I had to call my neighbour for help, and only after my neighbour opened the lock from outside, I managed to come out.

As soon as I came out, the JCP personnel and other individuals fled from the spot, clearly indicating guilty and preplanned intent.

This proves that the entire incident was premeditated to prevent me from objecting and to freely demolish my property in the dark hours.

5. Police Response at Night

-After gaining access, I immediately contacted local police. However, the on-duty Mr. Pema inquiry officer informed me that and asked me to file a detailed complaint the next morning. I also mailed an urgent complaint email to Matigara PS the same night regarding the incident.

6. Losses & Criminal Offences Committed

-These individuals have committed serious offences including:

Criminal trespass

House-trespass at night

Criminal intimidation

Wrongful confinement (locking me inside)

Mischief causing damage

Destruction of property

Unlawful demolition without authority

Harassment & continued threat

Theft/loss of business equipment

Under the provisions of IPC Sections 341/342/441/442/506/427/447/34, along with relevant sections of Criminal Damage and Trespass laws, these acts are punishable offences.

7. Demands for Immediate Legal Action

I therefore request your immediate intervention for: Registration of FIR against all persons involved in the illegal demolition, trespass, and confinement. Complete investigation including seizure of CCTV footage from surrounding areas. Verification of any alleged demolition authority/order, and if none exists, declaring it illegal. Identification of all JCP personnel and private individuals present at the scene.

Protection of my property and business from further illegal acts.

9. Prayer

Sir, the accused have repeatedly violated the law, taken the law into their own hands, and destroyed my livelihood. If urgent police action is not taken, they will continue to target me and my family and may cause further harm.

I request you to treat this matter urgently and ensure that strict criminal action is taken against all guilty persons and that my property rights and personal safety are protected.
