Sir,

In producing herewith the 01 (one) arrested accused person namely Gobinda Roy, S/O- Ganesh Roy of Srirampur, PO- Trimohoni, PS- Hili, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, (A/P- Bypass More, PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling) (not verified) along with the following seized article under proper seizure list :-

- (i) One transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be brown sugar weighing 483 (four hundred and eighty three) grams and marked as 'Exhibit-A'.
- (ii) One ash coloured four wheeler SANTRO having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 and marked as 'Exhibit-B'.
- (iii) One black coloured I Phone 15 having IMEI No- 3512322740256122/3511232740791748 and containing one Jio sim having no- 6295288791.

I, PSI Avijit Banik, of Matigara Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 13.01.2026 at about 16:15 hrs, received a specific information provided by a credible source that 01 (one) person is waiting in a four wheeler car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 with huge quantity of brown sugar for selling at Suor (pig) Hati near Lexican More, under Matigara PS.

Hence, there was a strong reason to believe that there is every chance of committing a cognizable offence under NDPS Act and to check the veracity of information, I reduced the information in writing vide Matigara PS GDE No. 722, Dated- 13.01.2026 and I intimated the information to Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, I/C Matigara PS, SPC who brought the information to the superior and after obtaining necessary order at about 16:25 hrs myself, along with a team of Matigara PS, SPC consisting of ASI Bikash Roy, ASI Dipak Kr. Chhetri, ASI Chandra Prakash Adhikari, C/219 Sanatan Chitrakar, C/868 Sujal Roy, C/523 Sanjit Kuridu all are of Matigara PS, SPC took departure vide C.C. No- 119/2026, dated 13.01.2026 from Matigara PS, SPC for Suor Hati near Lexican More under Matigara PS with investigation kit containing envelope, white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, digital weighing machine and other investigation kits by a Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was diarized vide Matigara PS GDE No. 723, dated- 13.01.2026.

At the same time I also informed the videographer namely Somnath Chatarjee, S/O- Sushil Chatarjee of Aurobindo Pally, Gokhel Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling to be present at Suor Hati near Lexican more, under Matigara PS. SPC to prepare the video of whole process of search and seizure if any. On 13.01.2026 at about 16:40 hrs, we reached at Suor Hati near Lexican More under Matigara PS and I met with my source and he briefed me about the detail information. Before that I looked up for public witnesses to the entire process of search and seizure. I found so many people but two of them gave their willingness to act as independent witnesses. The particulars of the witnesses are as follows 1] Karan Paswan, S/O- Lt. Dharam Paswan of Harekrishna Pally, PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and 2] Nandan Sahani, S/O- Lt. Ram Swarup Sahani of Harekrishna Pally, PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and I briefed them about the information we had and requested them to stand as witness, who agreed to be stand as witness during the process of search and seizure and other process thereafter. Then my source indicated the four wheeler car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 which was parked at the parking place near Suor Hati and accordingly we proceeding towards the car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140.

In the meanwhile, I/C, Matigara PS sent a message to SDO, Siliguri to depute an Executive Magistrate during search & seizure of NDPS substances as per norms vide ORG No. 86/2026, Dated- 13.01.2026. But after a telephonic conversation, it came to know that due to engage in other duty and short notice, there are no Executive Magistrate available to perform the duty.

In the above circumstances and the gravity of the information, if any delay occurred, the suspected person may escape. Hence, as per order of superior, Sri Anil Roy, Inspector of Police, Detective Department, Siliguri Police Commissionerate left for the place of occurrence to supervise the search & seizure if any.

At about 16:55 hrs, we had been near the car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 and managed to apprehend the suspected person. I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police officers. I appraised him about the information in hand and started to examine him thoroughly. On interrogation he disclosed his name and address as mentioned above. On interrogation initially the detained person denied having any brown sugar with him and the car does not contain any brown sugar. But I told him that we want to search the car carried by him. Eventually he admitted that he is possessing a huge quantity suspected to be Brown Sugar at his car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 and waiting for his designated customer to sell.

As per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained to the above noted detained person that he has the legal right to tender the searching process in front of an Executive Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer and the same was given to him in writing. In reply he wanted to be searched before any officer and he does not want to search the police team. At about 17:15 hrs Sri Anil Roy, Inspector of Police, Detective Department, Siliguri Police Commissionerate arrived at the spot as a Gazetted Officer, where I briefed him the information in a nutshell. Also introduced the witnesses as noted above.

On further interrogation, the detained person admitted in front of the Gazetted officer that he was in conscious possession of a huge quantity of Brown Sugar at his car and waiting for his designated customer to sell the same.

Thereafter, in presence of the Gazetted officer, and the two independent witnesses I searched the detained person namely Gobinda Roy after observing all formalities and found one I-Phone 15 having IMEI No- 3512322740256122/3511232740791748 and containing one Jio sim having no- 6295288791 from his possession. Then the car having Regn No- WB 74 J 6140 of the detained person was searched and found one transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be brown sugar which was kept below the left side front seat of the car. On interrogation, the detained person stated that he brought the suspected to be brown sugar from Kaliachak, Malda and selling these to his designated customer at Biswas Colony area under Matigara PS. Then, I asked him to produce the valid license/ documents for possessing the huge quantity of illegal narcotics contraband articles which was recovered from his car but he failed to produce any legal papers.

After weighting the transparent plastic packet which was recovered from the car of the detained person in his possession is weighted 483 grams. Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the NDPS Act and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated by the NDPS Act. Accordingly, I had seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list duly prepared by me in presence of independent witnesses and Sri Anil Roy, Inspector of Police, Detective Department, Siliguri Police Commissionerate who acted as Gazetted officer. I also took signatures of the witnesses, the accused and the Gazetted officer and submitted my signature as seizing officer.

Thereafter, 483 (four hundred and eighty three) grams suspected to be Brown Sugar have been properly marked and labeled as 'Exhibit-A' and the ash coloured four wheeler SANTRO having Regn No- 74 J 6140 from where the brown sugar was recovered labeled as 'Exhibit-B'. Took signature of witnesses and the accused in the label in presence of the Gazetted officer.

I then arrested the above noted accused person after informing him the ground of arrest for possession of contraband Narcotic drugs under the NDPS Act and issued an arrest memo to him accordingly, duly signed by the accused and witness.

The entire process of Search, seizure, Label, Seal and arrest were done in between 17:25 hrs to 18:05 hrs. The entire process of search, seizure, sealed and labeled was done under the supervision of Sri Ganesh Roy, Inspector of Police, Detective Department, Siliguri Police Commissionerate who acted as the Gazetted officer and videography of the search and seizure process was conducted through the camera of S/O- Sushil Chatarjee of Aurobindo Pally, Gokhel Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling in compliance with the Order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances you are requested to kindly lodge a FIR under the relevant section of law and arrange for its investigation against the accused namely Gobinda Roy (26 yrs old), S/O- Ganesh Roy of Srirampur, PO- Trimohoni, PS- Hili, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, (A/P- Bypass Road), PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling) (not verified) and others involved in this racket.
