Sir,

In producing herewith following seized articles viz,

- one white colour nylon hand bag containing twenty (20) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up, each bottle containing 600ml, in total 12 liters, which is marked as exhibit A.
- one bottle of Himalayan Gold, containing 600 ml marked as exhibit A-1, which I randomly taken out from exhibit A.

I, SI Youel Lepcha, S/O Jai Tshering Lepcha of Bhaktinagar Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, would like to lodge a written complaint against Jyotish Haldar (29 years), S/O Lt Haradhan Haldar of Amtola Shrastinagar, Bottle Company, Ward No. 41, PS Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri. On 14/01/2026, at about 21:25 hours, I received information indicating that an individual was roaming around Donbosco Road with illicit liquor, without any valid license. I recorded this information in the PS General Diary Entry (GDE) as Bhaktinagar PS GDE No. 672/26 dated 14/01/2026, and informed the In-Charge of the police station. Following his directive, I, along with ASI Khagen Barman, ASI Dipak Karmakar, ASI Dhurba Mishra, and Constable 374 Debraj Biswas—all from Bhaktinagar PS—proceeded to Donbosco Road to verify the information.

Upon our arrival at 21:45 hours, we identified and detained an individual carrying a white nylon handbag, as indicated by the source. We introduced ourselves as police personnel from Bhaktinagar PS. The individual disclosed his identity as mentioned above. I conducted a personal search as well as a search of the handbag. During the search, I recovered a total of twenty (20) bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP, each containing 600 ml of liquor, amounting to a total of 12 liters. When asked, he failed to produce any license to support the possession of the illicit liquor. Consequently, I seized the illegal liquor, following the proper seizure procedures in the presence of witnesses, after observing all necessary formalities at the location. The entire seizure process took place between 21:50 hours and 22:15 hours and was recorded via audio and video as per established norms.

I respectfully request that a specific case be initiated against Jyotish Haldar (29 years), S/O Lt Haradhan Haldar of Amtola Shrastinagar, Bottle Company, Ward No. 41, PS Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri, under the appropriate sections of law.
