I, Kishan Aggarwal, owner of vehicle no. WB 73L 5915.

I and my staff, Utpal Dutta, were in Saha Traders,
Upper Bagdogra for marketing purpose, I asked Utpal

Dutta to get some sweets from a nearby sweet shop
and gave him my motorcycle to go. As he started

the vehicle and went a little ahead, motorcycle
no. - WB 74BL 3592, came crashing into the vehicle.

The crash damaged bike's shockers, tyre rim, and
body from the right.

Upon confrontation, the bike rider started misbehaving
and trash talking. He also started threatening.

The rider was not wearing any helmet or any
other protective gear. On online inspection, we found
that he had challans for similar offences earlier.

Utpal Dutta is injured on both of his legs. His
medical report is attested to this letter.

The biker is almost of the age of 25 years. He was
rash driving and speeding. His mobile no is - 7001537970.

The accident took place on 7th January, 2025 at 4.30 pm.
