Subject: Complaint against Alok Paul and one unknown person for physical assault, criminal intimidation, and theft.

Sir,

I, Mintu Karmakar, son of Khokan Karmakar, resident of Swami Dayananda Marg, Khalpara, Siliguri Bazar, Siliguri, District Darjeeling, Law Clerk by profession, respectfully submit this complaint to bring to your notice a serious incident of physical assault, criminal intimidation, and theft committed against me.

Mr. Alok Paul, resident of Vivekananda Pally, Bagdogra, Dakshin Bagdogra, District Darjeeling, had engaged me for professional services relating to land searching and deed drafting work. It was mutually agreed that the total consideration for the said work would be Rs. 10,000/-, out of which I received an advance payment of Rs. 5,000/-. Mr. Alok Paul assured me that the remaining Rs. 5,000/- would be paid immediately upon completion and handover of the documents.

After duly completing the assigned work, I was instructed by Mr. Alok Paul to meet him near Ashigarh More towards Bhavesh More on 15-01-2026 at around 7:30 PM for handing over the documents. Accordingly, I met him at the said place and handed over the draft deed along with all relevant papers prepared by me. At that time, Mr. Paul stated that he intended to complete the registry through another person. Although I did not raise any objection, I politely requested him to clear my pending professional dues of Rs. 5,000/-.

Instead of making the payment, Mr. Alok Paul began abusing me in filthy language and threatened me with dire consequences. When I again requested my legitimate payment, he suddenly became violent and forcefully pushed me very hard. Thereafter, Mr. Paul, along with one unknown person accompanying him, assaulted me brutally. During the assault, I was struck hard on my chest, causing me to fall to the ground and lose consciousness due to severe pain.

Taking advantage of my helpless condition, both individuals forcibly removed my brown-colored wallet from my pocket containing Rs. 3,000/- in cash, and also snatched a silver chain from my neck before fleeing from the spot.

As a result of this incident, I am presently under extreme fear, mental trauma, and physical distress. I humbly request you to kindly treat this matter as urgent, register a complaint against Alok Paul and his unidentified accomplice, and take necessary legal action to ensure my safety and the recovery of my stolen belongings.

I shall remain obliged for your prompt intervention.
