In producing herewith 01 (one) arrested accused persons namely Bharat Mandal (30) s/o Lt Sachin Mandal of Mohatpur, Kutipara PS Kaliachak Dist Malda along with seized articles as mentioned below:

- 1) One green colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 300 gram approx mark as "Exhibit A"
- 2) One white colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 449 gram approx mark as "Exhibit B"
- 3) One white colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 499 gram approx mark as "Exhibit C"
- 4) One Black colour school bag styled as safari with red colour chain Marked as "Exhibit D"
- 5) One Black colour Nokia keypad mobile phone vide IMEI No 359788201623136/3 along with SIM - 5G + 05251D8991000923486057016U
- 6) Serial no 1 to 03 kept inside the serial no 04.

I, SI Tanmay Kundu of New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that today on 14-01-2026 at about 12:10 hrs, I received an information from my credible source that one persons is illegally carrying a huge quantity of Brown Sugar, a controlled substance under the NDPS Act. He is expected to cross through, south colony area under NJP P.S for its clandestine disposal and his personal gain. This information suggests a strong likelihood of a cognizable offense under the NDPS Act being committed. If not acted immediately he would succeed to smuggle the same

I reduced the information in writing vide NJP PS GDE No.953, dated 14.01.2026 and I intimated the information to SI Partha Sarathi Das, Officer-In-Charge, New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, and after obtaining necessary order at about 12:15 hrs myself, along with a team consisting of I. Myself SI Tanmay Kundu, along with SI Sanik Paul, ASI Manoj Majumdar, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, C/ 453 Uttam Dey VP 13 Jamirul Islam, VP 08 Laxman Roy took departure from New Jalpaiguri PS for South Colony area under NJP P.S along with laptop, portable printer, weighing machine, Drug Testing Kits and other necessary documents articles required for operation availing Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was diarized vide NJP P.S GDE No. 959, dated 14.01.2026 and MCC No. 109/2026 dated: 14.01.2026.

At about 12:35 myself and raid team reached at South Colony main road near central School under NJP P.S, and met my source and he briefed me about the detail information. I then looked up for public witnesses and found 02 persons namely: 1. Amarjeet Kamti (46) s/o Lt Kameswar Kamti of Ramnagar Colony Majdoor Busty PS New Jalpaiguri Dist Jalpaiguri 2. Kartick Kamti (38) s/o Gouri Shankar Kamti of Ramnagar Colony Majdoor Busty PS New Jalpaiguri Dist Jalpaiguri briefed them the information in hand in a nutshell after listening to the information they both voluntarily agreed to stand as witness for the entire process of search and seizure. Thereafter, we ambushed at South colony main road near Central School under NJP PS. I contacted with videographer namely Tapan Mandal and asked him to come to the spot immediately and make video graphy of whole process of search and seizure if happen.

At about 13:05 hrs, we saw one person approaching towards South colony main road near central School from back side of New Jalpaiguri railway side. My source identified the person as our suspects accordingly we try to detain him but after seeing the police personals he try to ran away from us but somehow we managed to stop him and then cordoned him and I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police personal showing our Govt. ID proofs, I then appraised him about the information in hand and started to examine him. During examination, he stated his names as Bharat Mandal (30) s/o Lt Sachin Mandal of Mohatpur, Kutipara PS Kaliachak Dist Malda. I asked him if he had any ID proof then he stated that he had nothing with him now. On further questioning, the above noted detainee made contradictory statements at different times but finally he confessed that he was in conscious possession of huge quantities of brown sugar which were packed in plastic packet concealed inside his bag. I then immediately as per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained the above noted detainee and the same was given to him separately in writing stating that he have legal right to tender his personal search in front of a magistrate or a gazetted officer duly empowered under section 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended).

I then served Notice U/S 50 of NDPS Act to the detainee whether he was willing to be searched in presence of the police Gazetted officer or any gazetted officer of other department. In reply, he made his written consent to be searched in presence of the Police Gazetted Officer. I then contact to Officer-In-Charge of New Jalpaiguri PS and as per his direction I contact to Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police, of SPC for his presence at PO and stand as a gazetted officer.

At about 13:45 hrs, Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC arrived on the spot and I introduced him as Gazetted officer to the detained persons and the independent witness. I then narrated the development to him in a nutshell.

Thereafter Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC served Notice U/S 103 BNSS in writing to the above mentioned detained person and that, if he wish, he may

search every member of the searching team and the vehicles with us before the search of his person and his belongings. Then, the detainee denied to searched me and other raid team including Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC and Govt. vehicle as well as the above noted 02 public witnesses. Accordingly, I prepared a Nil seizure list. Duly signed by the detainees and raid team and witnesses.

Thereafter, in presence of Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC, 02 public witnesses and the raid team, I searched the detained person and also searched his black colour school bag styled as safari with red colour chain and during search I was able to recovered three plastic carry bag containing believed to be brown sugar. and weighed all the three plastic carry bag individually and the 1) green colour plastic bag containing 300 gram said to be brown sugar and mark as "Exhibit A" 2) One white colour plastic bag containing 449 gram said to be brown sugar and mark as "Exhibit B" 3) One white colour plastic bag containing 499 gram said to be brown sugar and mark as "Exhibit C", On preliminary interrogation, the above noted 01 (one) detainee have stated that he had brought the contraband Narcotic substance like brown sugar from kaliachak side and was carrying it to siliguri for its clandestine disposal. I asked him to produce any valid documents for carrying and possessing of the contraband articles but he failed to produce any legal papers.

Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the section 8C r/w 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated U/S-60 & 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985. Accordingly, I seized all the contrabands i.e., 1) One green colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 300 gram approx mark as "Exhibit A" 2) One white colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 449 gram approx mark as "Exhibit B" 3) One white colour plastic carry bag inside said to be brown sugar containing 499 gram approx mark as "Exhibit C" 4) One Black colour school bag styled as safari with red colour chain Marked as "Exhibit D" 5) One Black colour Nokia keypad mobile phone vide IMEI No 359788201623136/3 along with SIM - 5G + 05251D8991000923486057016U 6) Serial no 1 to 03 kept inside the serial no 04 U/S- 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) under proper seizure list duly prepared by me. Took signature of the witnesses and the accused person, signature of Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC as gazetted officer and also put my signature as seizing officer. Copy of seizure list was given to the detainee.

Thereafter, all the seized articles have been properly marked and labeled Took signature of witnesses and accused persons in the labels in presence of the Gazetted officer. The entire process of Search, seizure, Label, Seal & packing were done in between 14:05 to 14:25 hrs.

I then arrested above noted 01 (one) accused persons after informing him the ground of arrest for the possession and carrying of contraband Narcotic drugs Brown Sugar under the NDPS Act and issued arrest memo to him accordingly duly signed by the accused person and witness and provided a copy of the same. I also intimated the family members of above noted 01 arrested accused person regarding his arrest over mobile phone. During interrogation he reveled that one Bharat Mandal (30), s/o Lt

Sachin Mandal of Mohatpur, Kutipara PS Kaliachak Dist Malda is fully involved with him.

The entire process of detention, search, seizure sealed and labeled were videographed and under the supervision of Shri Tapan Shil, Inspector of Police of SPC in compliance to the Order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances, a case under sections, 21(c) /22(c) of NDPS Act, 1985 may kindly be started against the 01 (One) accused persons namely, Bharat Mandal (30) s/o Lt Sachin Mandal of Mohatpur, Kutipara PS Kaliachak Dist Malda and other persons involved in this crime and arrange for its proper investigation.
