Subject: FIR regarding theft of gold chain by suspected pickpocket/beggar racket at NJP Station parking area

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Prateek Chaudhary, aged 39 years, resident of BE-273, Salt Lake City, Kolkata - 700064, Mobile No. 9830357456, hereby lodge this complaint regarding the theft of my gold chain that occurred on 24 January 2026 at New Jalpaiguri (NJP) Railway Station parking area.

Brief Facts of the Incident:

1. I travelled along with my wife Bishakha Chaudhary (36 years) and our 1.5-year-old infant child from Sealdah (SDAH) to New Jalpaiguri (NJP) by Padatik Express (Train No. 12377), arriving at NJP on 24 January 2026 morning:
 - o PNR No.: 6761647233
 - o Coach/Seat: HA1, Coupe B/5 and B/6
2. After disembarking the train, while proceeding from the overbridge area near the Heritage Coach display towards the station parking area, I noticed that we were being continuously followed by multiple beggars, one after another, who appeared to be acting in coordination.
3. At approximately 9:30 AM, while boarding a cab from the parking area located behind the auto stand (two-lane car parking area, exact spot marked in attached image), I was loading luggage into the cab while holding my infant child in my hand.
4. At that moment, my child suddenly started crying, and one of her fingers showed reddening and skin irritation, indicating pain. Since the child is very young and unable to speak properly, and due to the surrounding confusion, we could not understand the reason at that time.
5. Immediately thereafter, the beggars who had been following us suddenly dispersed. We remained in the parking area for approximately 15 more minutes, but none of them were seen again.
6. We then proceeded in the cab and later stopped at Lemon Tree Hotel for breakfast. While using the restroom there, I realised that my gold chain was missing from my neck.
7. Upon reflection, I strongly suspect that the gold chain was pulled from my neck at the same moment when my child cried in pain, and the distraction caused thereby facilitated the theft.

Prayer:

I respectfully request you to kindly:

1. Register an FIR under appropriate sections of law for theft/pickpocketing.
2. Examine CCTV footage of:
 - o Overbridge area
 - o Heritage Coach display area
 - o NJP station parking area (especially the marked location)
3. Investigate the suspected organised beggar/pickpocket racket operating in and around NJP station premises.
4. Take necessary steps for the recovery of my stolen gold chain and initiate legal action against the offenders.

I undertake to cooperate fully with the investigation and to provide any further information as required.
