Subject- Written complaint against Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari.

Respected Sir,

This is to inform you that I Smt. Namita Mandal, aged about 44 years, wife of Prasad Mandal, resident of Thiknikata, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district Darjeeling, Pin 734012, begs to state you that on 14/12/2025 at around 3:00 pm one Bapi Roy, son of Paresh Roy and one Avinash Adhikary, son of Ajit Adhikari, both resident of Thiknikata, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district Darjeeling, Pin 734012 called my son namely Parthib Mandal, (aged about 25 years) son of Prasad Mandal, resident of Thiknikata, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district Darjeeling, Pin 734012, via phone and stated that they wanted to discuss something important with him and hearing such my son agreed to their proposal and went to meet the above said persons on Thiknikata ground at around 4:00pm in the evening.

It is pertinent to mention here that few days prior to this incident the above said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari along with my son Parthib Mandal, while plying their Honda Dio scooter met with a minor accident with another vehicle, although no one was harmed from the incident but the Honda Dio scooter in which they were plying got minor dents and scratches. Though my son was not driving the abovesaid Honda Dio scooter and was nowhere liable to compensate for any damages but still he paid an amount of Rs. 10,000/- through cash as an act of friendship but the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari with their malafide intentions called my son to extract more money from him.

After reaching the meeting point the above said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari started demanding Rs. 20,000/- more for repairing their Honda Dio scooter, upon hearing such statements my son stated that he had already helped them and now he is unable to help them further financially, upon denial the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari got furious and started to abuse my son with filthy languages, though my son remained calm and requested them not to do so but the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari got even more furious and started to beat my son with fist and blows, receiving such impact my son fell to the ground and tried to defend himself from the vicious attack. That the said Bapi Roy and Avinash

Adhikari also threatened my son with empty syringes and stated that if he failed to give them their money then they shall implicate him in false drugs case and if he tried to reach for any help they shall kill him, being helpless my son cried for help and requested them not to do so but the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari without listening to any of his request continued to attack him with fist and blows in head, stomach, back and arms with the intention to kill him.

Amongst the quarrel the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari hit my son in such a way that his right thumb bone got completely fractured into pieces, receiving such heavy hit my son shouted/cried for help and hearing such some of the locals gathered and the said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari fled the situation. Although my son was heavily injured and was in a complete shock but he still somehow managed to come home and stated me the entire incident. After hearing the incident I rapidly took my son for medical treatment at NMBC & H and after initial treatment I came to know about the injuries he received in different parts of his bodies among which the right thumb bone fracture was the most brutal (medical documents and bills are attached herewith), since then my son was admitted in different nursing home's for his treatment and I was engaged in his treatment procedures for which the delay was caused for writing you this written complaint.

Now being helpless I am writing you this written complaint to take appropriate/strict legal actions as per the appropriate provisions of law at the earliest against the above said Bapi Roy and Avinash Adhikari for brutally torturing, threatening my son namely Parthib Mandal which caused him a broken/fractured right thumb bone and after several medical treatments the fractured bone has still not been healed till date and my son is in deep agony and mental trauma since the incident, therefore I humbly seek your kind attention towards this matter and for which I shall remain forever obliged.
