In producing herewith two arrested accused persons namely (i) Anju Das (55/F), W/O- Lt Dilip Das, resident of Papia Para, PO-Ghogomali PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri (Aadhar No-269809881893) and (ii) Sukla Das (31/F), D/O- Lt Dilip Das resident of Papia Para, PO-Ghogomali PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri (Aadhar No-807432216301) (not verified) under custody along with the following seized articles [ Sl. No. I, II & III] under proper seizure list:-

(i) One transparent ziplock plastic pouch containing brown color substance suspected to be Brown Sugar in wet condition measuring weight approx. 286.870 (Two hundred and eighty-six point eight seven zero) grams and Marked as Exhibit-A

(ii) One VIVO V60e Smart Mobile phone bearing mobile no-9064671749, IMEI No-865932082374396/865932082374388 Marked as Exhibit-B.

(iii) Total Indian Currency Notes Rs. 12,910/ (Twelve thousand nine hundred and ten rupees) cash money of denomination (Rs. 500 \* 11=Rs. 5500/ + Rs. 200 \* 13=Rs. 2600/ + Rs. 100\*45=Rs. 4500/+ Rs. 50\*4=Rs. 200/+ Rs. 20\*2=Rs 40/+Rs. 10\*7=Rs. 70/).

(iv) One SanDisk Cruzer Blade USB 2.0 64 GB Flash Drive containing the audio-video records of search and seizure.

(v) One certificate u/s 63(4) (c) of BSA along with hash value-0080521e02ce6b98e80ca31fdb5a809.

[Note: (Sl. No. (i) & (iii) has been seized from conscious joint possession of both the female accused persons & Sl. No. (ii) has been seized from the possession of the accused Sukla Das).

I, SI Agen Lepcha, son of the late Dup Tshering Lepcha, presently posted at Ashighar Out Post under Bhaktinagar PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above-noted arrested female accused persons. On 04/02/26 at approximately 12:15 hrs, I received specific source information that two female suspects were dealing and selling narcotic substances from their residence at Papia Para, under the jurisdiction of Ashighar OP, and was in possession of a large quantity of narcotics for delivery to designated customers. The information was duly diarized vide Ashighar OP GDE No. 108 dated 04.02.2026. I immediately informed the Officer-in-Charge of Ashighar OP, Bhaktinagar PS, SPC, and as per his direction, a raiding team was formed. The team—consisting of ASI Dinesh Ch. Roy, C/970 Bikash Roy, C/1547 Prabir Das, LC/497 Jharna Roy, and LCV/50 Samprita Saha, all of Ashighar OP—was led by me. At 12:25 hrs, we departed for Papia Para in Government Vehicle No. WB-42-8829, equipped with an investigation kit to verify the veracity of the information (recorded vide Ashighar OP GDE No. 109 and M.C.C. No. 145/26 dated 04.02.26). I directed C/1547 Prabir Das to videograph any search and seizure conducted. Under the prevailing circumstances, it was determined that a search warrant or formal authorization could not be obtained without affording the offenders an opportunity to conceal evidence or escape.

At approximately 12:35 hrs, we reached the vicinity of Papia Para under Ashighar OP. Guided by the source, we identified the target house and laid an ambush. During this time, I requested two local residents—namely Kalpana Roy (40), W/O Niren Roy, and Manabi Roy (50), W/O Amal Roy, both of Papia Para—to serve as independent witnesses. I issued them written notices to witness the search, seizure, and arrest procedures, and they expressed their willingness to cooperate.

Upon receiving confirmation from the source that the suspects were inside, we entered the premises, disclosing our identities as Police officers of Ashighar Outpost, Bhaktinagar PS. We detained the two suspects based on a reasonable belief that they were in joint possession of narcotic substances for illegal sale. They identified themselves as Anju Das (55), W/O Lt. Dilip Das, and Sukla Das (31), D/O Lt. Dilip Das, and were confirmed to be mother and daughter. On interrogation, they confessed to possessing "Brown Sugar" within the house and admitted to dealing and selling the substance for the past two years. Adhering to the statutory requirements of the NDPS Act, I provided them with a written option to be searched in the presence of a Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer. Both suspects consented to be searched in the presence of such an authority.

Accordingly, I informed the matter to Officer-in-Charge of Ashighar OP and, as per his direction, contacted Shri Amit Adhikary, Inspector-in-Charge of Bhaktinagar PS, SPC, via telephone. I briefed him on the apprehension of the two suspects, Anju Das and Sukla Das, and requested his presence at the spot to supervise the search and seizure in his capacity as a Special Executive Magistrate. I further dispatched C/970 Bikash Roy with a formal written intimation to the IC, Bhaktinagar PS.

At approximately 13:42 hrs, Shri Amit Adhikary arrived at the spot. I introduced him to the detained persons and the independent witnesses, disclosing his identity as a Special Executive Magistrate. Before commencing the search, and in accordance with legal provisions, I offered both the suspects and the independent witnesses the opportunity to search the Police Party first; however, they declined. Subsequently, in the presence of the Special Executive Magistrate and the two independent witnesses, and duly assisted by lady police personnel, I conducted a thorough search of the suspects and the living room, which led to the recovery of the following:

(i) One transparent ziplock plastic pouch containing brown color substance suspected to be Brown Sugar in wet condition measuring weight approx. 286.870 (Two hundred and eighty-six point eight seven zero) grams and Marked as Exhibit-A

(ii) Total Rs. 12,910/ (Twelve thousand nine hundred and ten rupees) cash money of denomination (Rs. 500 \* 11=Rs. 5500/ + Rs. 200 \* 13=Rs. 2600/ + Rs. 100\*45=Rs. 4500/+ Rs. 50\*4=Rs. 200/+ Rs. 20\*2=Rs 40/+Rs. 10\*7=Rs. 70/).

(iii) One VIVO V60e Smart Mobile phone bearing mobile no-9064671749, IMEI No-865932082374396/865932082374388 Marked as Exhibit-B.

Note: (Sl. No. (i) & (ii) has been seized from conscious joint possession of both the female accused persons & Sl. No. (iii) has been seized from the possession of the accused Sukla Das).

The two accused persons identified the recovered substance as "Brown Sugar." When asked in the presence of the Special Executive Magistrate and independent witnesses, they failed to produce any valid license or documentation authorizing the possession of the suspected narcotic substance. Upon further interrogation, the suspects confessed that they had clandestinely procured the suspected "Brown Sugar" from the Bagrakote area of Siliguri for illegal distribution to designated customers for personal gain. They further disclosed their long-standing involvement in this illicit trade.

Once their direct involvement in the procurement, possession, and dealing of narcotics was established, I seized the aforementioned articles from their joint conscious possession at the spot. The seizure was conducted under a proper seizure list in the presence of the Special Executive Magistrate and the independent witnesses, with the accused persons acknowledging the process. The seized items were marked as Exhibit-A and Exhibit-B and duly labeled in the presence of all parties. The facts and the recovery of incriminating articles clearly indicate that Anju Das and Sukla Das have contravened the provisions of the NDPS Act by illegally possessing and dealing in narcotic substances. Then, I arrested the above noted female accused persons Anju Das and Sukla Das duly assisted by lady police personnel after observing all legal formalities as well as after communicating them the ground of arrest in writing as they have committed a cognizable offence in presence of Police Officers for possessing & carrying substance suspected to be brown sugar and issued memo of arrest in this regard.

The arrest information of the accused persons has duly been communicated to their family/relatives namely Nandita Roy, W/O-Shankar Roy of R/O- Sukantanagar, P.O-Rabindra Sarani, P.S- Bhaktinagar, Dist-Jalpaiguri (Mobile No-7477829964). The process of search and seizure was made between 13:43 hrs to 14:27 hrs on 04.02.26 and was done through audio-video electronic means using mobile phone and then the same audio-video record is converted to a pen drive using a computer system.

Under the above noted facts and circumstances, I request to you that a specific case under proper sections of law may kindly be started against the involved arrested female accused persons (i) Anju Das (55/F), W/O- Lt Dilip Das, resident of Papia Para, PO-Ghogomali PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri (Aadhar No-269809881893) and (ii) Sukla Das (31/F), D/O- Lt Dilip Das resident of Papia Para, PO-Ghogomali PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri (Aadhar No-807432216301) (not verified) and arrange for its investigation.
