

Sub : Handing Over of Seized Buffaloes and Registration of Case
Sir,

On 25.01.2026 at approximately 0010 hrs., a specific input received from Coy ACN regarding the smuggling of cattle by vehicle from Naxalbari towards Siliguri.

On receipt of the said information, the Coy Commander directed the undersigned to form a team comprising three other personnel. Accordingly, the team departed the camp in an SSB vehicle at 0045 hrs.

As per source information, a suspicious vehicle bearing registration number AS-01-PC-2696 was spotted on Asian Highway 2 near Naxalbari. When signaled to stop, the driver of the said vehicle deliberately accelerated and fled in an attempt to evade interception.

Subsequently, the vehicle was found parked on the roadside at near Kestopur. Upon reaching the location and conducting a search, no driver or other occupants were found in or around the vehicle. A thorough search of the vehicle led to the recovery of 20 Buffaloes (Pada). The manner in which the animals were being transported clearly indicated illegal transportation and cruelty to animals.

Accordingly, the animals were seized and taken into legal custody, and a seizure memo was prepared on the spot as per prescribed procedure.

In view of the above, the seized cattle (Buffaloes) are being handed over to PS Bagdogra on 25.01.2026 at 07:15 hrs. It is requested that a case may kindly be registered against the unknown driver/owner of the vehicle and that further investigation may be initiated as per law.
