1. Priya Dey, aged about 21 years, married daughter of Manoj Dey and Sampa Dey, resident of Siliguri Junction, Paticolony, Road No. 2, Ward No. 47, P.O. & P.S. Pradhan Nagar, District - Darjeeling, PIN - 734003, and presently residing at Hemanta Mukherjee Road, near Gouriya Math, Deshbandhu Para, Ward No. 30, S.M.C., P.O. & P.S. Siliguri Town, District - Darjeeling, PIN - 734004, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the following accused persons namely 1) Subhashish Sarkar, Son of Samir Sarkar and Sumita Sarkar, Resident of Siliguri Junction, Paticolony, Road No. 2, Ward No. 47, P.O. & P.S. Pradhan Nagar, District - Darjeeling, PIN - 734003. 2) Samir Sarkar, Son of not known. 3) Sumita Sarkar, Wife of Samir Sarkar.

1. That I am a law-abiding citizen and the legally married wife of accused no. 1. Accused no. 2 and 3 are my father-in-law and mother-in-law, respectively. All the accused persons were residing together with me at the above-mentioned matrimonial home.
2. That my marriage with accused no. 1 was an arranged marriage, solemnized on 20.02.2025 according to Hindu

rites and customs at Subrata Sangha Club, Deshbandhu Para, P.S. Siliguri, District Darjeeling, in the presence of relatives and well-wishers of both sides. After marriage, I started living and cohabiting with my husband at my matrimonial home.

3. That at the time of negotiation and solemnization of marriage, the accused persons demanded dowry, and under compulsion, my parents gave gold ornaments, furniture, utensils and other household articles as per their demand. Further, a cash amount of Rs. 6,12,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh Twelve Thousand only) was given as dowry to my husband.

It is pertinent to mention that prior to marriage, a sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- was transferred from my father's bank account to the bank account of the accused no. 3 (mother-in-law). After marriage, the accused persons again demanded money on the pretext of financial difficulty and received Rs. 1,00,000/- from my father.

4. That at the time of marriage negotiation itself, the accused persons demanded an additional sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh only) as dowry, which is illegal and punishable under law.

5. That during the reception ceremony held on 23.02.2025, my husband was in a drunken condition. When my mother objected to such indecent behaviour, accused no. 1 abused and insulted her in filthy language in front of relatives and guests. Later, when I protested privately, accused no. 1 became violent and slapped me, causing physical and mental cruelty.

6. That prior to marriage, accused no. 1 falsely represented that he was a graduate and employed in a reputed private company earning more than Rs. 20,000/- per month. After marriage, I came to know that all such representations were false, as he remained mostly unemployed and idle.

7. That accused no. 1 is a habitual drunkard and is involved in various unlawful activities. Whenever I protested, I was physically assaulted. When I informed my in-laws, instead of protecting me, they blamed me and subjected me to mental and physical torture.

8. That accused no. 2 and 3 continuously instigated accused no. 1 to harass me and repeatedly taunted me for bringing insufficient dowry, pressurising me to bring an additional sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- from my parental home.

9. That accused person No. 3 always behaved with suspicion towards me and made false allegations against me. He frequently checked my mobile phone and searched my almirah in order to look for money. Accused person No. 2 also used abusive and vulgar language towards me and made indecent remarks about my clothes, physical appearance, and body shape.

10. That it is pertinent to mention that the stridhan properties belonging to me were gifted to me and include one gold male finger ring, one gold bangle (Aisti), one silver waist chain, one pair of gold earrings, and one gold necklace, all of which are presently in the possession and custody of the accused persons.

11. That after marriage, the maid servant was removed and I was forced to do all household work without being provided basic necessities, food or financial support by my husband.

12. That my husband used to return home late at night in a drunken condition and on protest, he used to assault me, deny me food and stop communicating with me. Accused no. 2, being a retired BSF personnel, frequently threatened me by misusing his influence.

13. That I noticed that accused no. 1 maintained illicit online communication with other women and slept separately. On protest, I was beaten and threatened with dire consequences including death.

14. That on 10.11.2025, I was assaulted without any cause, and on 12.11.2025 at about 11:00 p.m., all the accused persons jointly assaulted and strangulated me in connection with further dowry demand and attempted to kill me, causing severe injuries. Thereafter, I was forcibly driven out of my matrimonial home.

15. That on 13.11.2025, I received medical treatment at Siliguri District Hospital. Even thereafter, the accused persons abused my parents over the phone using filthy language and made no attempt for reconciliation.

16. That efforts for settlement were made on 15.11.2025, but the accused persons refused reconciliation and openly challenged my father saying, "Do whatever you can."

17. That I reported the matter to the Ward Councillor of Ward No. 47 on 27.11.2025 and to the Family Counsellor, Siliguri District, on 08.12.2025, but no effective resolution was achieved.

18. That accused no. 2 is a pensioner, accused no. 3 is engaged in business and owns landed property, and accused no. 1 derives rental income of approximately Rs. 20,000/- per month from parental property. Despite having sufficient means, my husband has willfully neglected and failed to maintain me, causing extreme financial hardship.

19. That I am an unemployed undergraduate student of Siliguri Mahila College under North Bengal University and presently residing at my parental home due to cruelty and dowry demands.

20. That the delay in lodging the present FIR is neither intentional nor deliberate, but has occurred due to compelling and unavoidable circumstances. I was undergoing medical treatment and was suffering from severe physical pain, mental trauma and emotional distress. Further, with a bona fide intention to save my matrimonial life, I made sincere attempts to resolve the dispute amicably through family elders, the local Ward Councillor and the Family Counsellor. Moreover, due to continuous fear, intimidation, mental trauma and financial dependency created by the acts and conduct of the accused persons, I was physically and mentally incapable of lodging the written complaint before the police station immediately. Having no other efficacious

alternative left, I am now constrained to approach the police station to lodge this written complaint.

I therefore humbly pray that you kindly register an FIR under the appropriate sections of law and take necessary legal action against the accused persons.
