Respected Sir,

I, Apurba Saha, S/O- Lt. Digendra Nath Saha, resident of Hakimpara, P.O. & P.S.- Sliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, West Bengal, do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that I have constructed a hotel namely, "The Autograph Inn" situated at Thakur Nagar, Eastern Bypass main road, P.S.- Bhakti Nagar, now N.J.P., under partnership basis with my wife Smt. Shampa Saha (Paul) by taking a huge bank loan and some financial loan in the form of unsecured loan from Mohit Bhakat & Ors. The said Mohit Bhakat and his family members were known to me since last few years by virtue of my profession as a Tax Consultant & Practitioner.

Mohit Bhakat was very close to me and I repose trust on him & due to his enthusiasm; I allowed him to look after the day-to-day work of the hotel as I was very busy in my profession.

I had given Mohit Bhakat free hand to act on my behalf in the day-to-day administration/ management of the said Hotel business. I had believed him to such extent that he was even allowed to keep staff as per his requirements. However, after some months I noticed that the earning of the hotel was somehow not enough to meet up the bank loan interests & other expenditure.

On my scrutiny I found some financial discrepancies and on my asking the said Mohit Bhakat could not furnish the true picture of the accounts. One day the said Mohit Bhakat took away all the original bills, vouchers & money receipts from the Hotel. Till date the said original documents had not returned to me. Finding no other alternatives seeing the condition of my hotel which was running at loss, had decided to sell the said hotel.

At this stage Mohit Bhakat & his family members had created several disturbances to sell my said hotel. It maybe they were afraid of losing their money which was around Rs. 65,20,234/- given to me as loan in the month of March end, 2023.

However, lastly one person namely Biplab Saha had agreed to purchase my said hotel. It was to my utter surprise that after getting the news of selling of my hotel, the said Mohit had contacted the purchaser of my said hotel & suddenly the purchaser Mr. Biplab Saha had reduced the sell amount to the tune of Rs. 75 Lakhs. Since, I was in extreme financial disturbance due to the heavy bank loan, was compelled to handover the said hotel to on 06-12-2024.

After getting the money from Biplab, I had paid the said loan amount of Rs. 65,20,234/- through several cheques to Mohit Bhakat & Others. But I smelled the conspiracy in between Mohit Bhakat & the purchaser of the hotel namely Biplab Saha & Ors. On 14.02.2025, when Biplab Saha paid cash of Rupees one crore fourty one Lakhs four hundred seventy-one, in cash to Mohit as if this amount was spent by Mohit Bhakat in course of running my hotel without my knowledge & consent.

I became shocked very much but could not protest the same as I had to pay back bank loan and loans from others. Mohit Bhakat & his father giving me threat supported by Mr. Biplab Saha to cancel the deal of sell of hotel. They did not listen my words. I just wanted to dispose off the hotel at any means because I was not in a position to pay back bank loan.

I had to give another cheque of Rs. 60 Lakhs as a security deposit to Mohit Bhakat due to the insistence of Mr. Biplab Saha. I am certain that Mr. Mohit had made several forged bills, vouchers, money receipts one to defraud me & to deprive me from my hotel. The said forged documents are still lying with Mr. Mohit Bhakat which are to be recovered.

Furthermore, Mr. Biplab Saha in collusion with Mr. Mohit Bhakat had paid Rupees one crore fourty one Lakhs four hundred seventy-one to Mohit Bhakat out of the sale process of the hotel most illegally. Maybe they had planned to share the amount in between themselves only to cheat me. Till date I will get an amount of rupees 95 lakhs from Mr. Biplab Saha & also some security deposits, input Tax Credit on GST for purchase of hotel furniture & I also made security deposits & others in different Govt. agencies which is around 2 to 2.5 crores. Mr. Biplab Saha is not paying the said amount to me causing several financial difficulties to me.

I believed that Mr. Mohit Bhakat had fraudulent and dishonest intension, from one very beginning to cheat me & to grab my hotel, Mr. Mohit Bhakat taking the opportunity of my absence from the said Hotel due to my professional hazards, had misappropriated huge sum of money. He along with his engaged staffs had definite intension to cause financial loss & to ruin my reputation in the society. Thereafter, Mr. Mohit in collusion with Mr. Biplab Saha had latched up a plan to cause economical loss & to defraud me for their illegal personal gain.

I therefore request you please take immediate suitable legal action against- (1) Mr. Mohit Bhakat, S/O- Hari Nayan Bhakat of Jyostna Apartment, Rani Laxmi Sarani, Milanpally, P.O.- Siliguri Bazar, P.S.- Siliguri, Dist.- Darjeeling. (2) Mr. Biplab Saha, S/O- Nitai Saha, the present owner of Hotel "The Autograph Inn" & Others and thus obliged thereby.
