In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely ~~Badhan Bhowmik~~ (M/24) S/O- Ratan Bhowmik of Kawakhali, PO- Sushrutanagar, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling along with seized articles viz (1) 06 bottles Budweiser Premium king of Beer each bottle containing 650 ml. (2) 02 bottles Blenders Pride ultra-premium whiskey each bottle containing 375 ml (3) 03 bottles Old Monk xxx premium rum each bottle containing 180 ml, totaling 5.19 litres of liquor and lodged this complaint against the aforesaid accused person for start a specific case on the fact stated herein:--

Today at 00.25 hrs received a secret source information from a credible source that one person having a fast-food shopat NBMC & Hospital old gate isselling liquor in huge quantities for purpose of wrongful gain without any valid papers or license. Accordingly, I informed the matter to my superiors and myself along with SI Abhijit Das, ASI Bhanu Pradhan and available forcemoved towards NBMC & Hospital old gate to work out the information.

We reached the identify spot at 00.45 hrs. and my source pointed out the first food shop and above noted accused person from the reasonable distance and we started follow the accused person from reasonable distance. The said accused person was selling liquor to his designated customers. On seeing the police party, he tried to fly away from the shop but however we could manage to apprehendhim. On searching of his shop, wefound the above said seized articleswhich on interrogation he stated that he selling the same at his first food shop. On being asked he could not produce any legal documents or any licence for selling such type of liquor. Finding no other alternative, I seized the aforesaid articles in presence of local witness and duly singed by them. The said accused person arrested U/S- 35 of BNSS for selling liquor illegally, seizure list of the seized items were prepared and labelled. The entire process of search, seizure was made in between 01.35 hrs to 02.10 hrs with proper videography through WB E- Sakshya application.

The said accused person brought to PS along with all seized items and requested you that a specific case may kindly be start under proper section of law against the arrested accused person as noted above and oblige.
