Subject: Complaint against my husband, Ritesh Sherpa, my father-in-law Chuck Tshring Sherpa, my mother-in-law Shanti Sherpa, and my elder sister-in-law Rita Sherpa for mental and physical torture.

1. Smt. Phurki Lamu Sherpa, wife of Ritesh Sherpa, resident of Kalamjote, P.S. Matigara, District Darjeeling, would like to lodge a formal complaint against my husband Ritesh Sherpa, my father-in-law Chuck Tshring Sherpa, my mother-in-law Shanti Sherpa, and my elder sister-in-law Rita Sherpa for continuously subjecting me to mental and physical torture.

My marriage with my husband was solemnised on 03.04.2006 following a love relationship. From this marriage, I gave birth to my first daughter in 2008 and my second daughter in 2019. Since our marriage, my husband has subjected me to continuous mental and physical harassment, thereby disturbing the peace of our home. I would also like to state that I contributed 3,00,000 towards the construction of the house where we are presently residing. My two daughters are also deeply traumatised due to his behaviour. My father-in-law, mother-in-law, and sister-in-law regularly instigate my husband to mistreat and torture me.

My in-laws constantly taunt me for giving birth to two daughters and continue pressuring my husband to have a male child. My father-in-law even tempted my husband by promising to deposit one lakh rupees in his account if I gave birth to a male child. I am not a machine capable of determining the gender of a child according to their wishes. When I refused this pressure, my husband assaulted me and has continued to subject me to mental torture. I am not financially strong enough to raise three children, and I have already attained the age of 44 years. I live in constant anxiety and fear along with my daughters.

On 27.12.2024, my husband, father-in-law, mother-in-law, and younger sister-in-law picked a quarrel with me without any reason. My husband Ritesh Sherpa physically assaulted me by biting me, and my father-in-law Chuck Tshring Sherpa, mother-in-law Shanti Sherpa, and younger sister-in-law Reena Sherpa (who had come to stay for two months) also participated in the assault. My mother-in-law slapped and bit me in front of neighbours, claiming she had the right to do so. I then called the emergency number (100) for help. The police arrived and advised them to live peacefully, but after some months they resumed torturing me and told me to leave the house.

On 4th January and 11th January 2025, my elder sister-in-law Rita Sherpa came to my house late at night (between approximately 12:00 midnight and 2:30 am.) and shouted at me abusively. On 02.02.2025, I requested members of the Panchayat, church elders, and neighbours to intervene and take strict action. They issued a final warning to my in-laws to live peacefully, failing which action would be taken.

Recently, they have begun blaming me for any misfortune or possible death in the family, claiming it is because of me. They have threatened to throw me out of the house and have also

made complaints against me at my workplace. They are misleading and brainwashing my children as well. This has compelled me to take this step.

On the evening of 08.02.2026 we 2026, my husband again assaulted me and used abusive language in front of my daughter. My daughter is currently appearing for her annual examinations, but due to his behaviour she is deeply disturbed and unable to concentrate on her studies. He has threatened to kill me if I do not leave the house and has stated that he will marry another woman to have a male child.

I have been continuously subjected to mental and physical torture because I was unable to give birth to a baby boy, and they appear determined to continue this harassment until their demand is met.

Therefore, I humbly request you to provide me with police protection so that my life and the lives of my daughters may be secured.
