I, SI Debabrata Kundu of Bagdogra PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint against the arrested accused person named Rubel SK, aged 22 years, s/o- Late Ajijul SK, resident of Kulgachhi, PO- Kulgachhi, PS- Sagardighi, Dist- Murshidabad (Aadhaar No. 3182 1394 4673) to the effect that today on 14.02.2026 at 19:15 hrs I received a specific source input that one suspect has been waiting on NH-27 flyover near Gurudwara with two bags and he has possessed & carried substance suspected to be Ganja. He will proceed to Kaliachak for delivering the same to his designed customers. He has worn black colour jacket & white colour trouser (jeans). He could be caught red-handed if raided immediately. The matter was diarized vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 684 dated 14.02.2026 and I informed the matter to the Officer-in-Charge of Bagdogra Police Station, S.P.C. As per his kind direction a raiding team is formed consisting SI Samik Paul, ASI Munna Ahmed, VP/01 Anselam Kujur, CV/375 Jogesh Barman & CV/386 Kishor Ranjan Howladar, all of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C. being headed by me and at 19:25 hrs we left for NH-27 flyover near Gurudwara under Bagdogra PS by Govt. vehicle No. WB61A/0137 with investigation kit to verify the veracity of the information in hand vides Bagdogra PS GDE No. 685 dated 14.02.2026 and M.C.C. No. 10/26 dated 14.02.2026. Then, I contacted with the videographer named Nikhil Sarkar, aged 49 years, s/o- Late Bhupendra Sarkar,
