Sub : Handing Over of Seized Buffaloes and Registration of Case

Sir,

On 14.02.2026 at about 2315 hrs, based on specific information received from the Coy Commander regarding the transportation of cattle smuggled from Nepal by vehicle from Keshtopur to other places of India, a joint Ops party (special vehicle patrol) of C & B Coys was constituted. The Ops party under the command of undersigned, along with five (07) other officials of C & B Coys, was proceeded for the operation. The Ops team of C Coy departed from Panitanki camp in Govt Vehicle at 2335Hrs and was joined by B Coy team.

At about 0055 hrs, while the party was approaching the abandoned area of Tepu Tea Garden, Keshtopur, Bagdogra (WB), a Tata 1109 DCM vehicle (Colour- Mahroon) bearing registration No. WB455498 & Mahindra Bolero Pickup bearing No. WB 63A5643 Vehicle (Colour- White), were noticed.

Upon reaching the location and conducting a search, no driver or other occupants were found in or around the vehicles. A thorough search of the vehicle led to the recovery of 20 (twenty) buffaloes (Pada) big size loaded inside the Tata 1109 DCM vehicle & 03(Three) buffaloes (Pada) big size loaded inside the Mahindra Bolero Pickup (Total 23 Buffaloes(Pada) big size Inside the both vehicles). The manner in which the animals were loaded for transportation clearly indicated intention to illegally transport the smuggled buffaloes and cruelty towards those animals.

Accordingly, the animals were seized on spot and a seizure memo was prepared on 15.02.2026 at 0135 Hrs as per the prescribed procedure.

In view of the above, the seized cattle 23 buffaloes (Pada) & both vehicles (Tata 1109 DCM vehicle (Colour- Mahroon) bearing registration No. WB455498 & Mahindra Bolero Pickup bearing No. WB 63A5643 Vehicle (Colour- White), are being handed over to PS Bagdogra on 15.02.2026 at 0630 hrs. It is requested that a case may kindly be registered against the unknown driver/owner of the vehicle and other miscreants related to illegal smuggling and transportation of cattle in organized manner with request that further investigation may be initiated as per law.
