Subject: Complaint regarding dowry demand, harassment, physical and mental cruelty, criminal intimidation and forcible expulsion from matrimonial home

Respected Madam,

I, Rubina Khatun, wife of Makshed Alam and daughter of Md. Basir, resident of Damragram, P.O. Gulma, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling, beg to state that I am married to Makshed Alam, son of Mustafa Hussain of Dakshin Bholapara, P.O. Sabchpara, P.S. Rajganj, Dist. Jalpaiguri, which was solemnized on 22.12.2023 according to Muslim rite and customs. At the time of marriage, my parents provided sufficient stridhan articles including gold jewellery, clothes, household articles and other valuables according to their capacity, yet soon after marriage my husband and his family members started demanding additional dowry and continuously pressured me to bring Rs. 5,00,000 (Rupees Five Lakhs) and more gold jewellery from my parental home. When my family expressed their inability to fulfill such illegal demands, the behavior of my husband and his family became extremely cruel and violent towards me. My husband Makshed Alam, father-in-law Mustafa Hussain, mothers-in-law Halima Begam and Lalbanu Begam, brothers-in-law Ejabul Hussain and Majidul Hussain, sister-in-law Rubina Khatun, all residents of Dakshin Bholapara, P.S. Rajganj, Dist. Jalpaiguri, along with my husband's uncle Moynul Hoque of Bengupara, P.S. Rajganj, Dist. Jalpaiguri, in furtherance of their common intention, regularly abused me in filthy language, humiliated me, assaulted me on several occasions, and subjected me to severe mental and physical cruelty for not bringing money from my father. I was repeatedly threatened that if the dowry was not paid, they would kill me and make it appear as a suicide. My husband never protected me and instead supported his family members and their illegal demands. Somehow I managed to scream and call the neighbours, and then I was saved. And finally in the month of December 2024, I was forcibly driven out of my matrimonial home and took shelter at my father's house. Despite repeated attempts by my family members to amicably settle the matter, the accused persons refused to take me back unless their dowry demands were met. After some months, my husband came to my parental home and stayed there for a period, but when we asked him to take me back, he stated that his family would not allow my entry without dowry. Later, in the first week of December 2025, he took me to my matrimonial home assuring that everything would be resolved, but immediately after my arrival all the accused persons again started abusing me, threatening me, and attempting to physically assault me while continuously taunting and pressurizing me to bring ₹5 lakhs and gold jewellery. They also threatened to hang me during the night if I failed to meet their demands. On 15 December 2025, they again drove me out of the matrimonial home and clearly warned me not to return without money and jewellery, and further threatened that if I approached the police they would kill me. Since then, I have been residing at my father's house in fear, insecurity and severe mental trauma.

In view of the above, I humbly request you to kindly register an FIR against the accused persons, provide me necessary protection as I have genuine apprehension of danger to my life, and initiate strict legal action against all the accused persons. I am ready to cooperate with the investigation and provide further details and evidence as required.
