Sub: FIR for Theft

Sir,  
I, Sri Shyamlal Agarwal S/o Late Sohan Lal Agarwal, resident of Kusum Apartment, Mukuda Das Road, Milan Pally, Siliguri, Pin - 734005, in the district of Darjeeling, would like to lodge a written complaint stating as follows:

1. That On 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 at approximately 7:15 P.M., I along with my family, left my home to visit the Shyam baba temple at Babupara, Siliguri and at that time I had properly locked the main door of my house before leaving. When I returned home at around 8:00 P.M., I found that main door's lock was open.
2. Upon entering my home, I found that Our Almirahs were open and clothes were thrown here and there, my almirah and inside it the locker were also opened, and valuable items inside it were missing. My daughter's almirah was also open, and the valuables inside it were also missing, and someone had stolen them.
3. That after checking my valuables, I found that my gold and silver jewellery and cash kept in the house were missing. Upon checking, I discovered that the following items were missing: Gold and Silver Jewellery worth Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs), cash worth Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakhs), and the keys to my Locker at SBI Bank were also stolen.
4. That we made all our endeavour of tracing the stolen goods but were unable to find the same.

5. That I immediately inquired the matter from my neighbours, but none of them had seen anyone breaking into my house.

That all my hard-earned valuables are stolen and that in aforesaid circumstances, I humbly request your good self for taking immediate and protective action and book the culprit under specific provisions of law.
