Sir,

In producing herewith the accused person named Binod Das, aged 42 years, s/o- Late Ram Bahadur Das, resident of Daragaon, Sukanta Nagar, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (Aadhaar No. 9488 6020 4047) under custody along with following seized articles under proper seizure list viz. twelve (12) bottles of "Himalayan Gold 60° UP Indian Made Liquor", each bottle contains 600 ml @ Rs. 170/-, out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-A (Total 7.2 ltrs, total value Rs. 2040/-).

I, ASI Amit Lama of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the arrested accused person named Binod Das, aged 42 years, s/o- Late Ram Bahadur Das, resident of Daragaon, Sukanta Nagar, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 19.02.2026 at 20:45 hrs received reliable source information that one person named Binod Das would come at the service road of AH-02 at Singhijhora TE with huge quantity of liquor in his possession with a view to sell the same illegally to his designed customer for his wrongful gain. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and as per direction of O/C Bagdogra PS, I along with ASI Munna Ahmed, VP/02 Pradip Roy & CV/389 Janak Singh left for the service road of AH-02 at Singhijhora TE under Bagdogra PS, SPC by Govt. vehicle No. WB61A/0137 to work out the secret source information. Under these circumstances any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidences as well as of the escape of the offender. The matter is diarised in GD vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 956 dated 19.02.2026. At around 21:05 hrs we reached at the service road of AH-02 at Singhijhora TE and had been waited there for source indication. After a while, at around 21:35 hrs the source indicated me the suspect and being indication & identification by source at around 21:39 hrs I managed to apprehend one suspect with the help of accompanying Police personnel and interrogated him. On interrogation, he revealed his identity as Binod Das, aged 42 years, s/o- Late Ram Bahadur Das, resident of Daragaon, Sukanta Nagar, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling. We disclosed our identity to him and the input we had. We searched for the independent witnesses to be present there as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any. Two independent witnesses named Barun Roy, aged 25 years, s/o- Late Ramsogarat Roy, resident of Singhijhora TE, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (Ph. No. 8207274702) and Shibu Singh, aged 33 years, s/o- Late Tapan Singh, resident of Matigara, Tumbajote, Jora Bridge, PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling (Ph. No. 7001815745) was there to witness the process of search and seizure, if any. Then, we searched the suspect who had carried a loaded bag in his right hand in presence of the Police personnel. On searching the bag, twelve (12) bottles of "Himalayan Gold 60° UP Indian Made Liquor", each bottle contains 600 ml @ Rs. 170/- was recovered from his possession. On demand, the detainee failed to produce any valid document/license for stocking, possessing & selling that liquor. He confessed that he has been stocking, possessing & selling liquor illegally since long time for his wrongful gain. His involvement is well transpired in this case. Accordingly, I seized that liquor (as noted above) from his possession under proper seizure list and at last, I arrested the involved accused Binod Das (as noted above) after observing all legal formalities and communicating him the ground of arrest in writing as he has committed a cognizable offence in presence of Police Officers for stocking, possessing & selling that liquor illegally and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest is made in between 21:39 hrs and 21:59 hrs on 19.02.2026 through audio-video electronic means using Govt. mobile App 'WB E-Shakshya' vides Evidence Certificate No. C-956-53811-20260219444410.


