This is to inform you that I Smt. Dipali Paul, aged about 62 years, wife of Samaresh Paul, resident of Kawakhali, Bidhanpally, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district- Darjeeling, Pin 734012, begs to state you that on 05/02/2026 at around 05:00pm in the evening my son namely Sukumaleshwar Paul, aged about 20 years were feeding the stray dogs outside our residence when our neighbor namely Laxmi Sarkar, W/o Gopal Sarkar, resident of Kawakhali, Bidhanpally, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district- Darjeeling, Pin 734012, suddenly started to accuse my son of using bad words towards her husband, although my son was busy feeding the stray dogs and did not even utter a single word towards our neighbor but the said Laxmi Sarkar started to abuse my son with filthy languages and threats.

Upon hearing the shouting of filthy abuses from Laxmi Sarkar towards my son I rushed outside my residence and confronted the above said Laxmi Sarkar with the intention to clear out the misunderstanding and requested her not to use such filthy/indecent languages towards my

son and resolve the matter but without hearing any of my request the above said Laxmi Sarkar started to slap my son above named multiple times. Witnessing such a scenario I tried to free my son from her violent act but the abovesaid Laxmi Sarkar choked my son's throat and as I was trying to free my son from her grip she eventually grabbed me with my hair and started to throw fist and punches in my head, neck and chest areas, as I am an elderly lady with multiple physical ailments from a prolonged period of time and I was unable to free myself from the grip of Laxmi Sarkar as she was getting more violent, in the course of the violent act of Laxmi Sarkar, she continued to abuse me with filthy languages before the whole neighborhood and she further stated that today she will kill me and end my family. Although I was screaming in pain and was crying for her mercy but the said Laxmi Sarkar showed no mercy and even tore my dress which I was wearing, but in the mean time my husband namely Samaresh Paul arrived and tried to free me from the grip of Laxmi Sarkar, although he somehow managed to do so but the said Laxmi Sarkar started to abuse my husband and even tried to attack him but my husband along with my son took me inside our residence and we locked ourselves in. Upon gathering of local people Laxmi Sarkar went inside her residence stating that if she get a second chance she will kill us all.

After such horrific incident my husband took me to North Bengal Medical College and Hospital (**medical documents attached herewith**) for my initial treatment where I was told about my different injuries I sustained throughout the violent act and I was prescribed complete bedrest, since then I am in a complete bed ridden condition as my physical and mental health is worsening day by day and till date I am undergoing treatment and for which the delay is caused for writing you this written complaint.

Now I am writing you this written complaint and humbly requesting you to kindly take immediate/strict legal actions the said Laxmi Sarkar,

W/o Gopal Sarkar, resident of Kawakhali, Bidhanpally, P.O. Sushruta Nagar, P.S. Matigara, district- Darjeeling, Pin 734012 as per the appropriate provisions of law at the earliest for which I shall remain forever obliged.
