Sir,

In producing herewith the 01 (one) arrested lady accused person namely Mayna Khatun (26 yrs approx), D/O- Md. Dilwar Hossain of Biswas Colony, PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) along with the following seized article under proper seizure list :-

- (i) One transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be brown sugar weighing 300 (three hundred) grams and marked as 'Exhibit-A'.
- (ii) One black coloured NOKIA keypad mobile phone having IMEI No- 353015619192983/9 containing Vodafone sim card no- 7432862170.

I, PSI Surajit Das, of Matigara Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 20.02.2026 at about 16:15 hrs, received a specific information provided by a credible source that 01 (one) lady is standing near Chota Hanuman Mandir at Matigara Bazar under Matigara PS with huge quantity of illegal suspected to be Brown Sugar for selling.

Hence, there was a strong reason to believe that there is every chance of committing a cognizable offence under NDPS Act and to check the veracity of information, I reduced the information in writing vide Matigara PS GDE No. 1175, Dated- 20.02.2026 and I intimated the information to Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, I/C Matigara PS, SPC who brought the information to the superior and after obtaining necessary order at about 16:35 hrs myself, along with a team of Matigara PS, SPC consisting of ASI Bikash Roy, ASI Chandra Prakash Adhikary, C/523 Sanjit Kundu, C/225 Arun Kr. Roy, C/1506 Bijoy Saha and LC/1316 Chandana Paul all are of Matigara PS, SPC took departure vide C.C. No- 492/26 dated- 20.02.2026 from Matigara PS, SPC for Matigara Bazar near Chota Hanuman Mandir under Matigara PS with investigation kit containing envelope, white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, digital weighing machine and other investigation kits by a Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was diarized vide Matigara PS GDE No. 1176, dated- 20.02.2026.

At the same time I also informed the videographer namely Somnath Chatarjee, S/O- Sushil Chatarjee of Aurobindo Pally, Gokhel Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling to be present at Matigara Bazar near Chota Hanuman Mandir, under Matigara PS, SPC to prepare the video of whole process of search and seizure if any. On 20.02.2026 at about 16:45 hrs, we reached at Matigara Bazar and I met with my source and he briefed me about the detail information and told me that the suspected lady is standing beside the Chota Hanuman Mandir. Before that I looked up for public witnesses to the entire process of search and seizure. I found so many people but two of them gave their willingness to act as independent witnesses. The particulars of the witnesses are as follows 1] Sikandar Chand Gupta (39 yrs approx), S/O- Suresh Prasad Gupta and 2] Vicky Chand Gupta (36 yrs approx), S/O- Suresh Prasad Gupta both are of Matigara Bazar, PO+ PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and I briefed them about the information we had and requested them to stand as witness, who agreed to be stand as witness during the process of search and seizure and other process thereafter. Accordingly we proceeding towards the suspected person.

In the meanwhile, I/C, Matigara PS sent a message to SDO, Siliguri to depute an Executive Magistrate during search & seizure of NDPS substances as per norms vide ORG No. 421/26, Dated- 20.02.2026. But after a telephonic conversation, it came to know that due to engage in other duty and short notice, there are no Executive Magistrate available to perform the duty.

In the above circumstances and the gravity of the information, if any delay occurred, the accused person may escape. Hence superior directed I/C, Matigara PS to be present at the place of occurrence to supervise the search & seizure if any. Accordingly I/C Matigara PS, Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee left for the place of occurrence as a Gazetted officer.

At about 17:10 hrs, my source identified the suspected lady who is standing near the Chota Hanuman Mandir at Matigara Bazar. After a hot chase we managed to apprehend the suspected lady. I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police officers. I apprised her about the information in hand and started to examine her thoroughly. On interrogation she disclosed her name and address as mentioned above. On interrogation the detained lady confessed that she is possessing and carrying a huge quantity suspected to be Brown Sugar with her.

As per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained to the above noted detained lady that she has the legal right to tender her personal search in front of an Executive Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer and the same was given to her in writing. In reply she wanted to be searched before any police officer. At about 17:30 hrs Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, I/C Matigara PS arrived at the spot as a Gazetted Officer where I briefed him the information in a nutshell. Also introduced the witnesses as noted above.

On further interrogation, the detained lady confessed in front of the Gazetted officer that she was in conscious possession of a huge quantity of Brown Sugar which was kept and concealed in the inside right side pocket of her churidar pant.

Thereafter, in presence of the Gazetted officer, and the two independent witnesses lady constable searched the detained person namely Mayna Khatun. During the search found one transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be brown sugar which is wrapped in a black colour plastic carry bag and one black coloured NOKIA keypad mobile phone having IMEI No- 353015619192983/9 containing Vodafone sim card no- 7432862170, from her possession.

On interrogation, she stated that she brought the suspected to be brown sugar to deliver her designated customer at Matigara Bazar area under Matigara PS. Then, I asked her to produce the valid license/ documents for carrying and possessing the huge quantity of illegal narcotics contraband articles but she failed to produce any legal papers.

After weighting the transparent plastic packet which was found in the possession of the detained lady is weighted 300 grams. Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the NDPS Act and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated by the NDPS Act. Accordingly, I had seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list duly prepared by me in presence of independent witnesses and Sri. Arindam Bhattacharjee, I/C Matigara PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate who acted as Gazetted officer. I also took signatures of the witnesses, the

accused lady and Gazetted officer and submitted my signature as seizing officer. Copy of the seizure list was given to the detained lady.

Thereafter, 300 (three hundred) grams suspected to be Brown Sugar have been properly marked and labeled. Took signature of witnesses and accused lady person in the label in presence of the Gazetted officer.

I then arrested the above noted lady accused after informing her the grounds of arrest for the possession and carrying of contraband Narcotic drugs under the NDPS Act and issued an arrest memo to her accordingly, duly signed by the lady accused and witness and the lady constable.

The entire process of Search, seizure, Label, Seal and arrest were done in between 17:40 hrs to 18:20 hrs. The entire process of search, seizure, sealed and labeled under the supervision of Arindam Bhattacharjee, I/C Matigara PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate acted as Gazetted officer and video graphed of search and seizure conducted through the camera of Somnath Chatarjee, S/O- Sushil Chatarjee of Aurobindo Pally, Gokhel Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling in compliance with the Order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances you are requested to kindly lodge a FIR under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation against accused person namely Mayna Khatun (26 yrs approx), D/O- Md. Dilwar Hossain of Biswas Colony, PO+PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling (not verified) and others involved in this racket.
