Subject: Complaint against (i) Amar Das- Amar Roadways ("Accused Person") and (ii) unknown accused persons for criminal intimidation

Respected Sir,

1. I, Ravi Kumar, being the authorized signatory of Amazon Seller Services Pvt. Ltd. ("ASSPL") ("Complainant"/ "ASSPL"), am filing the instant Complaint against the Accused Person and its proprietor, Amar Das (+91-9832362717) for Criminal Intimidation, and Disruption of business operations..
2. ASSPL that the Complainant manages and operates e-commerce marketplace i.e., [www.amazon.in](http://www.amazon.in) enabling third party sellers on the website to display, list and offer their goods for sale to end-customers in India, having its registered office Sattva Horizon, 2nd Floor, Survey No. 6/1 and 7/1, Vinayak Nagar, Kattigenahalli, Venkatahalla Village, Yelahanka Hobli, Bengaluru - 560064.
3. The Site in question is operated by the vendor 3P partner "Mahindra Logistics".
4. The Complainant invites vendors for scheduled transportation business through RFP process year on year basis. Notably, the Accused Person was given the scheduled business by the Complainant in 2020 as transport vendor to assist logistics and carriage operations at the site of NPJU, Garg Plaza, Village Kanchanbari, Bangla Basti, PO-Fulbari, Siliguri, West Bengal, IN, 734015 ("Site"), located within the jurisdiction of this police station run and operated by Complainant's 3P "Mahindra Logistics".

5. However, due to non-competitive prices offered by the Accused Person, the Complainant was constrained to replace the Accused Person with a different vendor this year. It shall be noted that the said appointment of a new vendor has been made pursuant to a valid commercial arrangement, and the Complainant has been carrying out transportation activities strictly in accordance with law.
6. Subsequent to the new appointment by the Complainant, Amar Roadways, who were previously engaged as a transport partner, has been acting with clear *mala fide* intent to disrupt the Complainant's lawful operations by quoting higher pricing during the RFQ process. Notably, the representatives and associates of Amar Roadways including the Accused Person have repeatedly threatened and now disrupted operations, especially on 17 February 2026 the Complainant's drivers and operational staff with verbal intimidation and coercive conduct, physically blocked and wrongfully restrained the Complainant's and other vendor's vehicles from entering and exiting the operational premises, interfered with loading and dispatch activities, and attempted to compel the Complainant to discontinue its contractual work with other vendors who have lawfully being given the scheduled business. The said acts are not isolated or accidental in nature but constitute a continuous and deliberate pattern of unlawful behaviour designed to create fear among personnel, obstruct legitimate trade, and cause wrongful loss and operational harm to the Complainant.
7. In view of the aforementioned illegal acts of the Accused Person, the vendors engaged by the Complainant are operating under constant fear and apprehension of harm, scheduled consignments are being unlawfully delayed, and the Complainant is suffering continuing financial loss and reputational damage. The situation has created a real and imminent risk of escalation into physical violence if not immediately restrained. The conduct of the Accused Person who owns Amar Roadways is deliberate and calculated to wrongfully restrain movement, intimidate personnel, and obstruct the Complainant's legitimate

commercial activities, thereby causing wrongful loss and disruption to lawful business operations.


In addition to the aforementioned illegal acts of Accused Person, the representatives of Amar Roadways have circulated and caused to be circulated certain videos through WhatsApp claiming that they will not allow any other entity other than Amar Roadways to act as logistics and transportation operations partner of ASSPL at the Site. Notably, the said videos have been deliberately disseminated with the intent to malign the reputation of the Complainant, intimidate its workforce, and interfere with its ongoing business operations. The circulation of such material is malicious, calculated to create panic and distrust among drivers and business partners, and amounts to a continued attempt to unlawfully pressure the Complainant into ceasing its lawful activities. The Complainant states that the contents of the said videos are entirely false and fabricated, and their circulation constitutes an additional act of harassment, criminal intimidation, and unlawful interference with legitimate trade.

9. To the utter shock and dismay of the Complainant, on 17 February 2026, a group of protestors associated with the Accused Person unlawfully blocked the main gate of the Site and wrongfully restrained vehicles belonging to other authorized vendors from exiting the Site, thereby severely disrupting ongoing transportation activities. Owing to the escalating obstruction, Mahindra Logistics (Complainant's 3P partner operating the sort center, NPJU) was constrained to call the PCR helpline (112) seeking immediate police assistance. In view of above, the concerned officials arrived at the site and temporarily intervened to unblock the gate of Site; however, the said officials did not engage substantively with the Accused Person and other vendors and advised that the matter be resolved amicably unless a formal complaint was filed. Despite the above the Accused Person along with other unknown persons resumed blocking the gate of the Site immediately after the officers left the Site and continued to obstruct the movement of other authorized

vendors, as a result of which operations remain materially disrupted and affected as on date.

10. The Complainant has a genuine and reasonable apprehension that unless immediate preventive action is taken, the accused persons may escalate their conduct, endangering the safety of drivers, staff, vehicles and public order at the site.
11. It is submitted that the present Complaint is *bona fide* and in the interest of justice, with no ulterior motive or vexatious intent.
12. The acts described herein clearly disclose the commission of cognizable offences, including criminal intimidation, wrongful restraint, mischief causing wrongful loss, and unlawful obstruction and interference with lawful business operations, all of which are punishable under the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other applicable laws. The conduct of the Accused Person is intentional, coercive and designed to cause fear, disruption and financial harm to the Complainant, thereby warranting immediate criminal action and preventive intervention by the authorities.
13. The above-mentioned facts and circumstances indicate commission of serious cognizable offence by the Accused Person which requires immediate intervention.
14. The Complainant is ready to co-operate and provide necessary assistance as is requisite for concluding fair, proper and impartial enquiry of the instant Complaint.
