Subject: General Diary Entry Regarding Financial Fraud, Harassment, and Intimidation

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Anuradha Chakraborty, residing at Lokhimoni Bhaban, PurbaDhantala, Fulbari PIN – 734015, would like to formally lodge this General Diary entry against my ex-husband, Mr. Sayan Das.

I state that I was legally divorced from Mr. Sayan Das in the year 2022, and since then, I have been residing with my minor daughter (aged 8 years) along with my parents. Post-divorce, he has been continuously harassing me by initiating baseless legal allegations and creating unnecessary disturbances in my life. These repeated acts have caused severe mental stress to me and my family. My daughter, being a minor, is also deeply affected by his conduct. She is scared of him and does not wish to speak to or meet him.

I further wish to bring to your attention a serious matter of financial misconduct. Mr. Sayan Das has used my PAN details without my knowledge or consent to make investments in mutual funds. I am unaware of when exactly these investments were made. However, it has come to my notice that during the financial year 2024-25, he withdrew an amount of approximately ₹6,50,000 from such investments. At the time of withdrawal, he used his own contact details and bank account for the transaction, but the investments were linked to my PAN. As a result, the tax liability arising from this transaction has been imposed on me, despite me having no involvement in the investment or withdrawal. This constitutes a misuse of my financial identity and has placed an unfair financial burden on me.

Additionally, I would like to report repeated incidents at my daughter's school. Mr. Sayan Das has visited the school premises multiple times and behaved in an aggressive and intimidating manner towards the teachers and school authorities. He has questioned and threatened them for not allowing him to attend Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs), despite existing legal and custodial arrangements. His conduct has caused fear and discomfort among the school staff and has disrupted the peaceful environment required for the children.

His actions appear to be deliberate attempts to harass me and create pressure by interfering in both my financial matters and my child's upbringing.

In view of the above, I request you to kindly record this General Diary entry and take note of these incidents. I also seek your assistance in preventing further harassment, misuse of my personal information, and intimidation by Mr. Sayan Das.

I am ready to provide any supporting documents or further details as required.
