Subject: Request for registration of FIR regarding physical assault causing "Grievous Hurt".

Respected Sir,

I, Prasenjit Biswas, (S/O Prodig Biswas) resident of NJP Bhaktinagar, Near Bank of India, P.S. NJP, Dis- Jalpaiguri, wish to state the following:

On February 2, 2026: between 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM, Raja Barman (s/o Parimal Barman, Address- NJP Bhaktinagar, Near Bank of India, P.S. NJP, Dis- Jalpaiguri) attacked me.

He struck me with great force on the left side of my head, just above the ear.

That immediately after the blow, the accused grabbed my throat and strangled me for about 10-15 seconds. During this time, I was unable to breathe, felt suffocated, and feared for my life.

He has been constantly threatening me, using his criminal past to intimidate me into not reporting this matter to the police.

That due to initial fear and a hope that the injury would heal, I did not report it immediately. However, as the pain intensified and my hearing became affected, I visited Siliguri District Hospital, February 7, 2026. That as per the medical reports (Audiogram & Tympanometry), there is severe damage to my left ear drum (No Seal) and Mild Conductive Hearing Loss in the right ear. The doctor has officially recorded this as a case of "Trauma".

Prayer:

In view of the serious nature of the injury, I humbly request you to kindly register an FIR against Raja Barman under the appropriate sections of the law. I am fully committed to cooperating with the investigation and can provide all medical documents evidence as required.
