**Subject: Complaint of misappropriation and loss of tyres and allied products from warehouse at Gora More, Siliguri — Request to register a FIR and investigate**

We, Maximus Enterprises (I) Pvt.Ltd., appointed Clearing & Forwarding (C&F) agents of JK Tyres & Industries Ltd., hereby lodge this formal complaint regarding misappropriation and loss of tyres, tubes, flaps and allied products from our warehouse at Gora More, Sahu Dangi, Dist. Binnaguri, Siliguri.

Facts of the case

- We operate and manage the above warehouse on behalf of JK Tyres & Industries Ltd., handling sales, dispatch, inventory control and related operations.
- During internal reconciliation it was found that several sales invoices were raised against customer accounts and system credit limits, but the goods corresponding to those invoices were neither delivered to the customers' counters nor found in the warehouse.
- The preliminary estimated quantity of the invoiced-but-not-delivered stock to consignee is approximately 300 plus Tyres or more of various sizes and categories, as per the ongoing internal company audit.
- Ongoing Internal company Audit findings as on 22.02.2026, is showing the scale of misappropriation may be much higher than the above quoted figure.
- Based on preliminary audit findings and internal enquiries, we suspect that Mr. Uttam Saha (S/o Mr. Goutam Saha, Shivmandir, Siliguri) and Mr. Suryakanta Sahu (S/o Mr. Benudhar Sahu, Jhimripali, Angul, Odisha), both employed as Warehouse In-Charges, along with some other persons/entities, have been involved in the misappropriation and loss of tyres, tubes and flaps.

Documents available

We enclose the invoice list; billing records, stock reconciliation statements, complaints received from customers to the company, and other supporting documents evidencing the discrepancy. (Attachments: Invoice list, customer complaints and supporting documents)

Relief sought

- Kindly register an FIR for misappropriation/ loss of Tyres and investigate the matter.
- Assist in tracing and recovering the misappropriated goods or their monetary value, and take such legal action as deemed appropriate.


