**SUBJECT-Complaint Regarding Physical Assault, Verbal Abuse, and Criminal Intimidation by my husband Sri Subrata Paul.**

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Smt. Bhaswati Paul, wife of Sri Subrata Paul, resident of Shaktigarh Road No. 2, District Jalpaiguri, PIN-734005, respectfully submit this complaint for your kind consideration. I wish to inform you that today at around 11:00 AM, my husband, Sri Subrata Paul, came to my residence in an intoxicated condition. After entering the house he demanded that I lend him an amount of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) and when I refused to give him the money, then immediately he started to abuse me with filthy and obscene language and threatened me, not only that he also **physically assaulted me brutally he hit me and also choked my neck with an intention to cause serious harm** but somehow I rescued myself with the help of my house help, during the assault he threatened to kill me by saying that he would murder me, hearing my cries, my household member Smt. Smitibala Barman and my mother Smt. Maisha Ghosh came and intervened, hearing my cries, my household help Smt. Smitibala Barman and my mother Smt. Maisha Ghosh came to rescue me. However, my husband also assaulted them mercilessly. He beat both of them and even choked my household help's neck with the intention to murder her. Further, he forcibly tore the clothes of my household help, thereby outraging her modesty and dignity.

Seeing the situation becoming life-threatening, I immediately called my friend Smt. Asmita Chakraborty (Advocate) and my neighbours for help. Within a short span, they arrived at my residence. However, upon seeing them, my husband again started abusing them with filthy language and threatened them that "**TORA KAHNGI MAGIR BACCHA GULO AKAHNE KI KORCHIS, AKHAN THAKE BHAG NOILE TODER CHUDE REKHE DEBO, HARAMZADI KOTHA KAR**"

Not only this again he stated to me that "**KI RE KHANKI MAGI TAKA DEH NOILE SOBAR SAMNE TOR JAMA KHULE TOKE CHUDE KHALPARA TE BECHE ASBO, JOLDI TAKA DEH KHANKI MAGI , AMI NESHA KORBO NOILE TODER SOB KOTA K DHORE CHUDBO AR JODI NA DIS AMAR MEY DUTO K BECHE MOD KHABO AMI, BUJHLI CHODNA**" again stated to beat me brutally.

Again, when I requested him to leave my house, he threatened to beat and kill our elder daughter, Miss Subhashree Paul, and stated that he would not let her go until I gave him money. He further threatened that if I did not give him money immediately, he would kill our daughter. On witnessing this, I and my household help tried to rescue my daughter, but he again assaulted both of us brutally,

causing injuries. During this incident, he also tore our clothes and made further obscene and threatening remarks **"KHANKI MAGI KAJER MASI EKTA TOR JAMA TO CHIRECHI ABAR AYE TOKE CHUDI BHALO KORE MAGIR BACCHA"**

Thereafter, I called my in-laws to come and take him back home and handle the situation. However, after hearing about the matter, they both switched off their phones. Despite repeated attempts to contact them, all efforts were in vain, as I was unable to reach them so that they could resolve the matter peacefully.

Thereafter, when my friend, Smt. Asmita Chakraborty (Advocate), instructed him to immediately return to his residence at Hakimpara, he reacted aggressively. With clear intent, he began using abusive and filthy language against her and attempted to assault her. Upon this, she immediately raised an alarm and called out to my husband. Hearing this, he became somewhat calm, stepped back, and retreated from the situation.

I again requested him to leave my residence, but he refused and continued to stay there, creating a nuisance and disturbance. His behaviour appeared to be intended to harass and mentally disturb me.

Due to his violent behaviour, I am in fear for my life and safety due to his violent behavior. Therefore, I request you to kindly take necessary legal action against him under relevant sections of law for assault, criminal intimidation, and domestic violence, and provide me protection.

Therefore, I humbly request you to kindly register an FIR against him under appropriate sections of law for physical assault, attempt to murder, criminal intimidation, outraging modesty, and domestic violence, and to take immediate necessary legal action against him. I also request you to provide protection to me and my family members.

I shall be grateful for your prompt action.
