Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Ashish Kumar Swarnakar of Asuragarh, Near Dalkhola Dist North Dinajpur (not verified) along with the following seizure as per seizure list:

[i] One (01) zipper plastic packet containing with 296 grams of suspected to be brown sugar & marked as- Exhibit-A.

[ii] One Oppo mobile phone having IMEI No-866658074284819 & 866658074284801 with sim No-7004407315 marked as -Exhibit-B.

[iii] One white colour Oppo mobile phone having IMEI No-867762071359993 & 867762071359985 with sim No-8877200500 marked as -Exhibit-C.

[iv] One chocolate colour leather bag & marked as Exhibit-D

(Note: - SL No-1 to 3 were kept in SL No-4)

I, SI Srimanta Chatterjee s/o Lt Debi Prasad Chatterjee of Matigara PS under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodged this written complaint against above mentioned accused person to the effect that on 25.02.26 at about 13.40hrs, I received a reliable source input that one male person was coming from Dalkhola side towards Siliguri through Bus with huge quantity of brown Sugar for delivering the same to his designed customers at Siliguri area for his wrongful gain. The matter was diarized in Matigara PS GDE vide No.1444 dated 25.02.26 and subsequently, I informed the matter to the I/C Matigara PS, SPC in writing and being directed by him, myself along with ASI Bikash Roy, ASI Dipak Chhetri, ASI Chandra Prakash Adhikary, C/868 Sujal Roy all of Matigara PS with investigation kit (envelope, white paper, sealing wax, gum, seal, Digital weighing machine (Certified by the weight and Metallurgy department) etc. left for Phashidewa Underpass, AH-2. Opposite ACP (West) office SPC under Matigara PS by govt. hired vehicle to verify the veracity of the information vide Matigara PS GDE no. 1445 dated 25.02.26 and M.C.C No-547/26 Dated 25.02.26. I already informed PS mobile van officer (K-32) ASI Raju Prasad Yadav along with his force C/585 S.N.Roy & C/989 S.N.Ghosh to remain present at Phashidewa more immediately as per order of I/C of PS.

Under this circumstance any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidence or facility for the escape of the offender.

Thereafter at 14.05 hrs we reached in front of Phashidewa Underpass, AH-2. Opposite ACP (West) office SPC and waiting there, meanwhile I called two independent witnesses namely; (1) Raju Roy-36yrs (ph-8514998110) s/o Lt Gopal Roy of Shantipur PS New Rangia PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling and (2) Sujan Singh-34yrs (ph-8327372304) s/o

Uttam Singh of Lenin colony, near house of Panchayet, PS Matigara Dist Darjeeling and disclosed our identity and informed them about the information in hand and requested them in writing to accompany us in the whole process during search and seizure, if any and they gave in writing about their approval to accompany Police during raid, search and seizure. After sometimes we found one suspect just got down from a bus and coming towards Phashidewa more under Matigara more. Being identified by my source we detained the above noted person along with one leather bag which was kept in his Shoulder. We disclosed him our identity as police personnel. On being asked he disclosed his identity as noted above. On further examination the above alleged person stated that he is carrying and possessing "Brown Sugar" with him. Being identified by source and the information in hand and stated him that he will be searched for the purpose. He admitted that he had illegally possessed brown sugar in his possession for selling the same to his designed customers as per requirement for his wrongful gain.

I then gave an option in writing whether he will willing to be searched in presence of an Executive Magistrate or Gazette Police Officer, on return he given written reply that he is willing to be searched in presence of Gazette Police Officer. Then I informed over telephone to Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara Police Station to come at Phashidewa Underpass, AH-2. Opposite ACP (West) office SPC requested him to presence during search and seizure of the Brown Sugar.

Accordingly at 14.50 hrs Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara Police Station arrived at the spot as Gazette Police Officer and subsequently, under his supervision in presence of witnesses the process of search of the detained person for conducted following all formalities and recovered the above noted articles from the exclusive possession of above noted accused person. Subsequently, being demanded in presence of Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, Inspector In-Charge, Matigara PS as Gazetted Police Officer the detained person failed to produce any valid document in support of possessing of the brown sugar.

Thereafter, I weighted the recovered packets with the weighing instrument and found total 296 grams Said to be Brown Sugar which was kept inside in a leather bag of above noted accused person. Then, I seized the above noted articles at the spot under proper seizure list duly signed by the independent witnesses. I also labeled and sealed all the articles under the supervision of Shri Arindam Bhattacharjee, Inspector In-Charge of Matigara PS and witnesses and accused person. The whole process of search & seizure has been audio & VDO graphed by videographer Sri Somnath Chatterjee. The whole process of seizure was made in between 15.10 hrs to 16.08 hrs.

Then, I arrested the above noted accused person namely Subodh Kumar Das-30yrs s/o Lt Deb Narayan Das of Gulab bag, PO Gulab bag, Belouri Mistitola, PS Sadar, Purnia, Bihar after observing all formalities and informing the ground of his arrest in written and issued necessary Memo of Arrest u/s 35 (3) of BNSS. On interrogation he stated that he procured the seized Brown sugar from Bihar to hand over the same at Siliguri one person.

From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles it is quite evident that the accused persons namely Ashish Kumar Swarnakar-38yrs s/o Dilip Narayan Swarnakar of Asuragarh, Near Bus stand, PS Dalkhola Dist North Dinajpur (not verified) is involved in procuring and selling of brown sugar illegally contravening the norms of NDPS Act.
