Subject: Complaint for Registration of Offence under Relevant Provisions of BNS

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Ms. Moumita Barman, daughter of Late Vivekananda Barman, residing at Shantiniketan Apartment, Block-20, Flat No. 1C, P.S. Matigara, Siliguri, West Bengal, by profession an Advocate and member of the Siliguri Bar, and a single mother, do hereby submit this formal complaint for registration of an FIR under appropriate provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other applicable laws.

That on 25th February 2026, during the morning hours, I was away from my residence for personal work.

At approximately 12:00 noon, my driver, Mr. Mohan, came to my flat to collect the car keys. At that time, Ms. Jhulik Sarkar, resident of Amlapara, Mathabhanga, w/o my ex husband manvendra sengupta, along with her father Mr. Tapan Sarkar, forcibly entered my residential premises by pushing their way inside without consent, authority, or lawful justification.

After unlawfully entering the premises, the said accused persons willfully committed acts of vandalism and mischief by damaging household articles and ransacking my flat.

They further used abusive, filthy, and defamatory language against me, shouting and uttering derogatory remarks with intent to insult and outrage my dignity.

Upon receiving telephonic information regarding the incident, I immediately informed the police department and also informed my former husband, Mr. Manavendra Sen Gupta.

In the meantime, hearing the noise and disturbance, neighbouring residents assembled and intervened. They found the flat open and the accused persons inside. My driver, Mr. Mohan, was physically assaulted. It is further stated that Mr. Manavendra Sen Gupta arrived at the spot and Jhulik Sarkar discharged pepper spray upon manvendra sengupta, my driver and neighbours, including Mr. Sanjay Mishra and his wife, causing irritation to their eyes.

Before leaving the premises, Ms. Jhulik Sarkar openly extended threats to kill me, thereby committing the offence of criminal intimidation and creating a grave and imminent threat to my life and personal safety.

Thereafter, in the presence of neighbours, my driver secured and locked the flat.

I state that I have not yet re-entered my flat due to reasonable apprehension of danger to my life. I am living under constant fear. My daughter, who is presently undergoing psychiatric treatment, and I are under severe mental trauma and distress as a result of the said incident.

I am presently unaware of the full extent of damage to my movable and immovable property or whether any articles have been dishonestly removed or stolen, as I have not yet inspected the premises.

The acts of the accused persons prima facie constitute offences including but not limited to:

House-trespass and criminal trespass

Mischief causing damage to property

Voluntarily causing hurt

Use of harmful substance

Criminal intimidation

Intentional insult with intent to provoke breach of peace

Any other cognizable offences disclosed upon investigation

PRAYER

In view of the above facts and circumstances, I respectfully pray that your good office may:

a) Register an FIR forthwith under appropriate provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other applicable laws;

b) Conduct a fair, impartial, and expeditious investigation;


c) Provide necessary protection to me and my daughter; and

d) Initiate appropriate legal proceedings against the accused persons in accordance with law.

I am ready and willing to cooperate with the investigation and provide any further statement or evidence as may be required.

Kindly treat this complaint as information of a cognizable offence and take immediate action.
