Sir,

I, Sub-Inspector SI Kaji Rejaul Karim of New Jalpaiguri Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, hereby submit that in compliance with the provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), I am producing herewith the articles mentioned in the enclosed seizure list, which were lawfully seized in connection with the incident described herein.

- i. One rubber tyre fully in burned condition with wire.
- ii. 10(Ten) no's of playcards of Janjati Ekta Jindabad containing message "Bhagaban Birsha Munda Ki jay, Janjati Samaj ne thana hai, Jihadio ko fanshi delwana hai."
- iii. 05 (Five) no's of orange colour of flag symbolizing "Om" and 05 (five) Nos of national flags lying on the road.
- iv. One banner of protest rally to Uttarkanya dated 26 Feb at 13.00 hrs containing message "Aar noi abedan, ebar ron hobe sangram aaro bhayankar hobe"
- v. 10(Ten) no's of stones in different size and colours.
- vi. One big size flex/banner having message "Janjati Suraksha Munda, Siliguri Uttar Banga Bikhab Rally, chalo Uttarkanaya, 26th Feb,2026"
- vii. 04(Four) no's of sandals in different size and colours.

I further lodge this suo moto complaint against Srawan Chik Baraik and approximately 1500-2000 other supporters of Janajati Suraksha Mancha that on 26.02.2026, between 15:15 hrs and 16:00 hrs, supporters of the said organization from Phansidewa, Khoribari, and other parts of Darjeeling District, unlawfully assembled without obtaining prior permission from the competent authority. The assembly gathered at Siliguri-Jalpaiguri Road and proceeded to stage an "Uttarkanya Chalo" programme starting from Jalpai More.

It is pertinent to mention that a prohibitory order under Section 163 of BNSS was duly promulgated and in force within a 1 km radius of Uttarkanya. In view of the said prohibitory order, the police had erected temporary road blockades. At Kathaltala, on Asian Highway-2, with the assistance of traffic barriers and rented bamboo structures to prevent any unlawful gathering from advancing towards the prohibited zone.

From the outset, the rally was highly agitated and unruly. Participants were shouting derogatory, provocative, and threatening slogans directed against the police administration and the Government of West Bengal. The rallyists were carrying protest posters, organizational flags, and national flags. Notably, several members of the unlawful assembly were armed with long bows and arrows, which are traditional weapons of the Janajati community but are capable of causing fatal injuries if used against human beings or animals.

When the unlawful assembly reached the temporary barricade, the police party on duty repeatedly requested the participants to disperse peacefully, informing them that they had no lawful permission to conduct the rally and that entry towards Uttarkanya was strictly prohibited under the prevailing order. However, the members of the assembly became further enraged and aggressive. They began shouting at the top of their voices and suddenly resorted to pelting stones and brickbats targeting the police personnel deployed at the spot vide N.J.P P.S special C.C no-497/26,498/26, 499/26, 500/26, all are dated-26/02/2026. As a result of such violent actions, several on-duty police personnel sustained bodily grievous injuries.

The unruly mob then forcefully dismantled the temporary barricades and committed acts of mischief by setting fire to tyres on the public road, thereby endangering public safety and disrupting traffic movement. They also threw the national flags, which they had been carrying, onto the road in a disorderly manner. In view of the escalating violence and imminent threat to life and public property, I declared the said gathering an unlawful assembly through the public address system and directed the crowd to disperse immediately; cautioning that failure to comply would necessitate lawful use of force.

Despite repeated warnings, the assembly continued its violent and disorderly conduct. Finding no other alternative to restore law and order and to protect public servants and public property, the police resorted to the use of water cannon and discharged tear smoke gas shells and grenades in a controlled manner, and subsequently chased the mob to disperse them. Thereafter, the members of the unlawful and violent assembly fled from the scene.

After successful dispersal of the unlawful assembly, during inspection of the place of occurrence, the articles listed in the seizure memo were found lying abandoned at the spot. The said articles were seized in accordance with due legal procedure and under a proper seizure list in compliance with the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita.

This is submitted for taking necessary legal action against the accused persons and other unidentified members of the unlawful assembly.

Under the above circumstances I am to pray a specific case u/s 189/191(3)/195(1)/195(2)/121(2)/326(f) of B.N.S, section 4 of the P.D.P.P Act, section 5 of W.B MPÓ Act & Sec 02 of The Prevention of Insult to Honour Act may kindly be registered and arrange for its investigation.
