Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested person namely Ajay Das (30 years) S/O Ashok Das of Salugara Bazar, ward no 42, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri along with following seized articles viz,

- 47 (forty seven) bottles of Himalayan Fata Fati 70 UP each containing 300 MI, each cost Rs 50/-, bottled by Himalayan Endeavour PVT Siliguri, West Bengal, which is marked as exhibit "A".
- one bottle of Himalayan Fata Fati 70 UP each containing 300 MI, marked as exhibit A-1, which I randomly taken out from exhibit A.
- 6(Six) Bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 UP, each containing 600MI,each cost 170/-, bottled by Himalayan Endeavour PVT Siliguri, West Bengal, which is marked as exhibit "B".
- one bottle of Himalayan Gold 60 UP, each containing 600MI, marked as exhibit B-1, which I randomly taken out from exhibit B.
- One white colour nylong bag marked as Exhibit "C".
- Note: In total 17.700 liters, Exhibit A&B were kept in Exhibit "C".

I, SI Youel Lepcha, S/o Jai Tshering Lepcha, presently posted at Bhaktinagar Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, beg to submit the following for your kind consideration. On 01.03.2026 at about 14:10 hours, I received credible source information that one Ajay Das of Salugara Bazar, had stored a huge quantity of illicit liquor at his house-cum-restaurant without any valid license. The information was recorded in the PS General Diary vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No. 28/26 dated 01.03.2026, and the matter was informed to the Officer-in-Charge. As per his direction, I, along with SI Uday Chakraborty, ASI Khagen Barman, ASI Dipak Karmakar, ASI Dhurba Mishra, Constable 374 Debraj Biswas, and LC 1228 Sushila Roy all from Bhaktinagar PS proceeded to Salugara Bazar to verify the information.

Upon arrival at about 14:45 hours, we identified and detained the said person at his house-cum-restaurant. After disclosing our identity as police personnel, I conducted a search in accordance with law. During the search, one white-coloured nylon bag was recovered containing: 47 (forty-seven) bottles of "Himalayan Fata Fati 70 UP", each containing 300 ml, 6 (six) bottles of "Himalayan Gold 60 UP", each containing 600 ml, bottled by Himalayan Endeavour Pvt. Ltd., Siliguri, West Bengal, amounting to a total of 17.700 litres of liquor.

On being asked, the accused failed to produce any valid license or document in support of lawful possession of the said liquor. During interrogation, he admitted that he had been storing and selling the liquor illegally for personal gain. Accordingly, the entire illicit liquor was seized following due legal procedure in the presence of independent witnesses after observing all necessary formalities at the spot. The seizure process was conducted between 14:55 hours and 15:25 hours and was properly documented, including audio-visual recording. Subsequently, the accused person was arrested under the relevant provisions of law (u/s 35 BNSS and applicable Excise Act sections).

I therefore request that a specific case be registered against the accused person under the appropriate sections of law, and necessary legal action be initiated.
