Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Dilip Sarkar (49) s/o Lt. Niranjan Sarkar of Surjasen Colony, Block C, ward No.-34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri, under arrest along with following seized articles;

- (i) 12 (Twelve) No.s sealed Bottles of Himalayan Gold Country spirit 60 up, each bottle containing 600 ml , Marked as Exhibit-A from which 01 bottles taken as sample for examination Marked as Exhibit-A1.

In this regard I ASI Manoj Majumdar I am submitting this written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today on 02.03.26 myself along with force while performing Night Mobile Van duty, received source information that one person is carrying Liquor illegally from Kashmir Colony towards NJP to sell the same to his designated customers without any valid license. Accordingly myself along with C/1462 Sajan Tamang, Constable Uttam Dey, and CV- 206 Biswajit Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for Kashmir Colony area to verify the veracity of information. On arrival at the spot it was found that one person mentioned above carrying Liquor illegally from Kashmir Colony towards NJP to sell the same to his customers for his wrongful gain, without any valid license to earn huge money for his livelihood. During interrogation he disclosed that he was carrying liquor illegally for selling, then I apprehended the said person, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I seized the above noted articles from his possession and preparing proper seizure List also labeled took signature of him as well as witnesses. Thereafter I arrested the said person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. the above noted accused person u/s 35 BNSS. as he violated the norms of Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made in between 23.55 hrs to 00.15 hrs (seizure Total approx 7.2 Ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against arrested person namely Dilip Sarkar (49) s/o Lt. Niranjan Sarkar of Surjasen Colony, Block C, ward No.-34, PS- NJP, Dist.- Jalpaiguri, and arrange for its investigation.
