In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Sachin Lepcha (M/46 Yrs) S/O Late Tshering Lepcha of Upper Bagdogra, Panighata Road, PS-Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling along with seized articles viz

- i) 11 bottles of Hayward-5000 Beer each containing 500 ml each, total 11 X 500 ml = 5.5 Ltrs, Total value, 11 X Rs. 110/- = Rs. 1,210/-, Marked as Exhibit-A and one Bottle taken as sample & Marked as Exhibit-A1.
- ii) 09 bottles of Mc Dowell's No.1 Superior Whisky, containing 180 ml each, total 09 X 180 ml = 1.62 Ltrs, Total value, 09 X Rs. 190/- = Rs. 1,710/- Marked as Exhibit-B and one Bottle taken as sample & Marked as Exhibit-B1.

The information was diarised vide D.D, SPC GDE No-06 Dt- 01.03.2026. I informed the matter to ACP,DD,SPC and as per his kind direction myself along with SI Basudeb Guha, SI Ganesh Roy, Const. 686 Arup Saha, LC- 1332 Jayanti Oraon and CV-150 Bikash Thakur all of DD, SPC left for Upper Bagdogra to verify the veracity of the source information. This refers D.D, SPC GDE No-07 and MCC No. 57/2026 Dtd- 01.03.2026. We reached at the spot at 19.35 hrs and on being identified by the source, our team cordoned the shop of accused person and entered the shop and found that the above mentioned person was selling ID liquor inside his shop to his customers. On seeing our team the customers fled away but we managed to apprehend the above noted person i.e Sachin Lepcha (M/46 Yrs) S/O Late Tshering Lepcha of Upper Bagdogra, Panighata Road, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling, who was storing & selling ID liquors to his customers. On interrogation he disclosed his name and identity as noted above. On demand accused Sachin Lepcha failed to produce any valid document or license from the appropriate authority for storing/selling liquor. He was running this business at his shop illegally without any valid license. The accused person violated the provision of Bengal Excise Act. Accordingly, in presence of witnesses, I searched the shop of accused person and above noted ID liquor was recovered. Accordingly I seized & labelled the same from the possession of accused person under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses and accused person, under proper videography. The seizure was made on 01.03.2026 in between 19.45 hrs to 20.40 hrs. I arrested the accused person preparing memo of arrest and intimated him the ground of arrest.

Hence, I pray to you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the accused person namely Sachin Lepcha (M/46 Yrs) S/O Late Tshering Lepcha of Upper Bagdogra, Panighata Road, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and arrange for its investigation.
