Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested person namely Taposh Roy (24 years) S/O Naresh Roy of Demdema Busty, near Sastick Apartment PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri, along with the seized articles.

- 1) One iron made improvised one shutter Firearm having its trigger, hammer and firing pin measuring approx 12 inches including its butt, body and barrel marked as exhibit A.
- 2) Two pieces of Ammunition inscribed as "KF, 8MM, marked as exhibit B.

Note: Exhibit A was kept & Concealed at the back side of his waist & exhibit B were kept in a left pocket of his trouser.

I, Sub-Inspector Youel Lepcha, son of Jai Tshering Lepcha, of Bhaktinagar Police Station, respectfully submit that on 04.03.2026 at approximately 21:45 hours, I received credible source information that one person was moving suspiciously with an arm at the PC Mittal bus stand under the jurisdiction of Bhaktinagar Police Station. The information further suggested that he was planning to commit a crime in the nearby area. Upon receipt of the information, I made a GD Entry vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No. 202/26 dated 04.03.2026 and informed the I/C, PS. As per his order, I, along with Sub-Inspector Uday Chatterjee, Assistant Sub-Inspector Dipak Karmakar, Assistant Sub-Inspector Khagen Barman, Assistant Sub-Inspector Dhurba Das, and Constable No. 374 Debraj Biswas, proceeded to the spot in a government vehicle.

At about 22:10 hours, we reached PC Mittal bus terminus, where I met the source who reconfirmed the information. Thereafter, we proceeded to the specified location. On the way, I requested two independent passers-by to act as witnesses after informing them of the purpose, and they willingly agreed. Their particulars are as follows: Adip Pradhan (42 years), S/o Tek Bahadur Pradhan, resident of Singbulli, Mirik, District Darjeeling, A/P PC Mittal under Bhaktinagar PS. Ratan Roy (32 years), S/o Naresh Roy, resident of Danga Para, Fatapukur, PS Rajganj, District Jalpaiguri, A/P Salugara under Bhaktinagar PS. On approaching the area, we noticed one person attempting to flee, but he was apprehended tactfully. On questioning, he disclosed his name as Taposh Roy (24 years), S/o Naresh Roy, resident of Demdema Busty near Sastick Apartment, PS Bhaktinagar, District Jalpaiguri.

After apprehension, we disclosed our identities and the grounds of his detention. He admitted that he was present in the area with a firearm and ammunition, intending to commit a crime. Initially, I offered him an opportunity to search the police team, which he declined. Thereafter, I conducted his personal search in the presence of the witnesses. During the search, the aforesaid articles were recovered from his waist. On demand, he failed to produce any valid license or documents in support of possession of the firearm and ammunition.

Accordingly, I seized and labelled the above noted recovered articles as per procedure. A seizure list was prepared in the presence of the witnesses, and their signatures were obtained thereon. The entire seizure procedure was made between 22:30 hours and 23:05 hours and documented in audio-visual records, I arrested him under Section 35 of the BNSS.

In light of the facts and circumstances mentioned above, I respectfully request that a specific case be initiated against Taposh Roy (24 years) S/O Naresh Roy of Demdema busty, near Sastick Apartment PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
