Subject: Complaint regarding house breaking, theft and request for immediate police action.

Sir,

I, Sanjay Dutta, S/o. Late Sourendra Mohon Dutta, aged about 65, residing at 97, Sreeman Sarani, Haiderpara, New Paulpara, Near Mahamaya Club, Siliguri, ward No 38, PIN- 734006 beg to state that my residential house is situated at 97, Sreeman Sarani, New Paulpara, Near Mahamaya Club, Siliguri, which falls under the jurisdiction of Ashighar Police Out Post.

That on 06.03.2026 at around 8.00/8:30 PM, it came to our knowledge that one or more person/s unlawfully entered into our house after breaking the grill of the back window. After entering the premises, the said person broke open the ground floor door, thereafter broke the lock of the collapsible (K.C.) gate, and further broke open the lock of the main door of the second floor.

Immediately after identifying the incident on 06.03.2026 at about 8.00 / 8:30 PM, we informed the Police Control Room over phone, and pursuant to such information police personnel came to our house around 9.00/9.30 PM and inspected the place of occurrence for preliminary investigation.

The said person committed theft of several household articles including but not limited to:

One small mobile phone without SIM, One new gas oven, Various household utensils, Other articles, all the metal water taps from the house. The said person also broke open the almirah kept on the ground floor and rummaged through the belongings.

In view of the above, I humbly request you to kindly treat this letter as a formal complaint, register the same, and initiate necessary investigation for house breaking and theft, trace the accused person, and recover the stolen articles including the mobile phone at the earliest. Necessary steps may also kindly be taken to prevent any misuse of the said mobile number/phone.

It is further stated that the said miscreant, after entering the premises, broke all the water taps fitted in the bathrooms and stole the same. From the manner in which the incident has been carried out and considering the previous similar occurrence in our house, we reasonably suspect the involvement of one person of the locality known as "Mr. Tiya", who is residing at Haiderpara, Paulpara, Siliguri.
