Sir,

I, ASI Raju Prasad Yadav of Matigara Police Station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge a suo motu complaint against: 1. Arun Mandal 2. Pradip Chowdhury 3. Mithun Pramanik 4. Sourav Sarkar 5. Arijit Das 6. Bikash Sha 7. Shivji Singh 8. Kanaiya Pathak 9. Amit Kumar Gupta 10. Jitendra Saha 11. Ratan Mandal 12. Ram Singh 13. Shyamal Ghosh 14. Rajesh 15. Arijit Das and 50-60 other supporters of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). On 10.03.2026, I along with police force was detailed for Law and Order duty vide CC No 1176/2026 dated 10-03-2026 in connection with the Parivartan Rath Yatra organized by the leaders and supporters of BJP. The rally was scheduled to start from Check Post under Bhaktinagar PS and proceed towards Bihar More under Bagdogra PS via Sevoke Road to Panitanki More → from Panitanki More to Bidhan Road via Venus More → from Hill Cart Road via Siliguri Junction → from Siliguri Junction via Darjeeling More → Khaprail More → Matigara → Balason Bridge (NH-31) via Shivmandir → from Shivmandir to Bihar More → and from Bihar More towards Hathighisa, Naxalbari through NH-31, as per the proposed route submitted by the BJP Siliguri Organization.

However, at about 12:15 hours, when the rally reached Bypass More under Matigara PS, the rally suddenly diverted towards Old Matigara Road, which was not part of the approved route proposed earlier by the BJP Siliguri Organization, district, vide reference Nil dated 21.02.2026, submitted before the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate. More or less 120/130 supporters and a quite a number of vehicles viz WB 76 B 4700, WB 73 P 5515, WB 73 N 0096, WB 73 E 8173, WB 70 R 6246, WB 66 AL 2424, WB 02 AK 0949, WB 58 AR 1711, and few more were in the rally.

The police team present at Bypass More tried to convince the rally leadership and requested them to follow the approved route of the Parivartan Rath Yatra, but the leaders and supporters present in the rally did not pay heed to the request of the police team. As the situation became tense and appeared to go out of control, I informed you for the deployment of additional police force. Accordingly, SI Sobin Yonzon, SI Kalyan Saha, C/1433 Milton Rahaman, C/1400 Parimal Ch. Mandal and C/1398 Biswajit Roy rushed to the spot and again tried to convince the BJP leadership that the rally did not have official permission for the altered route and that they were not following the designated route submitted earlier in writing. It was also brought to their notice that a large number of people had gathered at Old Matigara Road (Hat/Market area) due to the scheduled local assembly, making the situation potentially unlawful and sensitive. Despite of repeated requests from the police, the leaders and supporters became agitated and aggressive. They started using abusive and filthy language against the police personnel, raised political slogans, and blocked the road, thereby creating panic in the area. As a result, pedestrians, local residents, and even serious patients travelling towards Matigara BPHC were stranded.

Subsequently, the leaders and supporters created a loud commotion and proceeded towards Khaprail More via Old Matigara Road. During this process, they assaulted the police personnel including myself, causing injuries to several members of the police team, who were later treated at Matigara BPHC.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a specific case under Sections 189(2)/189(3)/190/195(1)/132/115(2)/117(2)/3(5) of the BNS be kindly registered against the above-named persons and 50-60 other BJP supporters, and that necessary investigation be initiated accordingly.
