Subject: FIR regarding demand for extortion money of ₹1,00,000 per month and deliberate damage to three vehicles

Respected Sir,

I, **Ajit Kumar Mishra**, Son of Late Lalan Kumar Mishra, resident of College Para, Kadamtala, Baramohan Singh Jote, Ranidanga, Kadamtala, Darjeeling, West Bengal, 734011, hereby submit this complaint and request you to kindly register an FIR regarding a serious incident of extortion and property damage.

On **11/03/2026** at approximately **09:00 PM**, at **Rangia, Siliguri** one person **Bappu Roy**, Son of Lalifa Roy, Contact no. 9749826788, approached me and **illegally demanded an Extortion money of ₹1,00,000 (One Lakh Rupees) per month** from me. When I refused to pay the illegal demand, the accused became aggressive and intentionally stopped my three vehicles and started damaging them in anger. The details of my vehicles are as follows:

Vehicle 1 – Registration No.: **WB73G2346**

Vehicle 2 – Registration No.: **WB73G2614**

Vehicle 3 – Registration No.: **WB73F2057**

The accused forcefully broke the rearview mirrors, side mirrors, and other parts of the vehicles, causing significant damage and financial loss to me. The estimated repair cost is approximately **₹2,50,000**.

The accused also threatened me with serious consequences, stating that if I do not pay the demanded extortion money of ₹1,00,000 per month, he will kidnap me from my house. This threat has created serious fear for my safety and the safety of my family members.

This act was **intentional, unlawful, and done to threaten and pressure me into paying illegal extortion money**. Such behaviour has caused me financial loss, fear, and mental harassment.
