With due respect, I, **SMT. POULOMI HALDER (BARMAN)**, D/O Pulin Halder & W/O Sri Subrata Barman, presently residing at Subhashpally, P.S. Siliguri, Dist. Darjeeling, in the State of West Bengal and permanently residing at South Ektiashal, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, beg to state that in the month of November, 2024 my marriage was registered as per the Special marriage act and thereafter on 29.04.2025 my marriage was solemnized with Subrata Barman, S/o Amulya Barman, resident of South Ektiashal, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, in the State of West Bengal, as per Hindu Rites & Customs at my parents house situated at South Ektiashal, P.S. Bhaktinagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri, in the State of West Bengal. At the time of marriage, my parents and other relatives and well wisher have gifted me gold neckles, gold finger rings, gold earrings, gold bracelet, gold bangles, gold chain etc weighing approximately 100 grams and I also received from my parents and other relatives other wooden furnitures including Box Khat, dressing table, washing machine, cloths, etc amounting to Rs. 10,00,000/- and after marriage I have taken all the above mention gold and furnitures to my husbands house and after reaching at my husband's house, my mother-in-law namely Lalo Barman, father-in-law namely Amulya Barman, my brother-in-law namely Ashim Barman, and his wife namely Tanima Mitra and another sister-in-law namely Chumki Barman @ Singha and my husband has taken all the above mention gold from me and kept those gold and valuable utensils, furnitures, clothes in their own custody.

That soon after the reception ceremony of my marriage, my husband, my my mother-in-law namely Lalo Barman, father-in-law namely Amulya Barman, my brother-in-law namely Ashim Barman, and his wife namely Tanima Mitra created pressure upon me for bringing an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- (Ten Lacs)

only from my parents and when I expressed the inability of my father to arrange the same, my husband and other in laws member created tortured upon me both physically and mentally. My husband used to assault me by fist and blows for demand of Rs. 10,00,000/- only. I was not provided sufficient food and I was not allowed to talk with the neighbors.

But I have bear all such type of inhuman torture with a hope that one day everything will be normalized. But things got worse day by day. My husband beat me mercilessly almost every day and at that moment my mother-in-law without rescuing me from the clutch of my husband, she used to instigate my husband that if the demand of Rs.10,00,000/- if not fulfilled, they will kill me and they will arrange another marriage of my said husband. And thereafter I expressed all these things to my father and after hearing such type of inhuman activities by my husband and other in-laws, my father and mother came to my matrimonial house and requested my husband to lead a happy marital life with me and at that time my said husband assured my father that he will rectify himself and will lead a happy marital life with me. Thereafter in the month of april, 2025 my said husband created pressure upon me in order to take a loan in my name for his fulfillment of wish and findings no other alternatives and for the sake of my marital life, I took loan from Axis Finance of an amount of Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs fifty thousand) only. But thereafter again in the month of December, 2025 my said mother-in-law again demanded money from me and at that time when I refused their said proposal at that moment my said mother-in-law ousted me from my matrimonial house and I took shelter at my parental house. And thereafter when my family members asked my husband about such type of incident at that time my said husband assured my father that he will reside with me in a separate mess and thereafter on the very same month i alongwith my husband are started to reside at Subhashpally in a rented mess. But the same tortured were never stopped upon me by my husband and today i.e, on 14-03-2026 at about 11:30-12:00 pm my said husband again demanded money from me and when I expressed my inability to meet such type of illegal demand by my husband, at that moment my said husband rammed towards me in order to kill me and when I tried to escape from the clutch

of my husband, at that very moment my said husband pushed me on a bed and physically assaulted me by using belt and tried to kill me and for this I got serious injury in my body and also ousted me from the rented house and finding no other alternatives I came at my parental house.

Sir, it is pertinent to be mentioned here that I have requested my husband as well as his family members in order to stop such types of inhuman activities with me but on every occasion my said husband and his mother demanded money from my father and openly declares that if their demand does not fulfilled then he never accept me as his wife. So findings no other alternatives I came before your good self with a prayer that please investigate the above matter and take necessary legal steps against my husband and other in-laws in accordance with law and obliged thereby.
