Subject: Written Complaint

Sir,

With due respect I the undersigned would like to inform you that I am an unfortunate father as well as a father-in-law aged about 76 years old suffering from various ailments and victim of continuous mental and physical torture as inflicted by my one of the daughter-in-laws namely Smt. Amrita Singh, her father namely Sri Shiv Kumar Singh upon me and my other family members from the very inception of the marriage i.e., 13.05.2011 with my one of the sons' namely Mukesh Kumar Singh {since missing}. After the said marriage my said daughter-in-law Smt. Amrita Singh and my son Mukesh Kumar Singh has started to live together as husband and wifewith me along with my some of other family members.

I would further like to inform you that out of the said wedlock my said daughter-in-law had given birth of female child and one male child. My said son Mukesh Kumar Singh had no stable income and practically due to the continuous torture as inflicted by said daughter-in-law upon him he left a private job wherein he was engaged as a Security Guard and he used to earn a very paltry amount of salary like Rs. 8000/- (Eight Thousand) per month and due to such continuous torture my son had become very depressed. My said daughter-in-law used to put pressure upon my son for arranging a separate accommodation elsewhere as she was not comfortable with us for staying further and on refusal she left my place on 06.08.2015 along with her daughter and started to live in her fathers' house and after elapsing of few months the father-in-law of my son threatened my son with dire consequences and told to leave my place and start to reside in his place at Uttar Raikatpara, P.S. Kotwali, District - Jalpaiguri, and due to such tremendous pressure my said son left my place and shifted and started to live with his wife in the place of his father-in-law on and from the month of December 2015, taking his all belongings.

I would like to further inform you that on 19.09.2016 my daughter-in-law gave birth her second child (male) and after the birth of said new born baby the father-in-law of my son has started to put pressure upon him to bring money from me out of my retirement benefit as I am a retired Railway Employee and

also from my other sons' for purchasing of a flat in the name of my daughter-in-law and due to refusal, his father-in-law had threatened my son with dire consequences by saying that he is a police personnel (Jail Police) posted at Jalpaiguri Correctional Home and he had good contact with so many prisoners who committed heinous crime and he would engage one of them for killing me and my son and my other family members and if we don't fulfill their illegal demand. In the meantime my daughter-in-law has filed an application for maintenance against my son being Misc. Case No. 66/2018 before the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalpaiguri and one case of Domestic Violence being Misc. Petition Case No. 87/2018 against my son and all other family members for maintenance before Learned C.J.M, Jalpaiguri apart from that she also lodged a false complaint to O.C. N.J.P. Police Station on 06.05.2018 and on the basis of said complaint one case has been started against us being N.J.P. Case No, 316/2018 Under Section 498A of I.P.C..

I would like to further inform you that due to such threatening and out of the fear of death and pendency of those false cases, my son had become fearful and shocked and he somehow returned to my place in the 1st week of February, 2019, and I noticed that my son had started to behave most unusual and without informing anyone he left my place on 17.02.2019, in the morning at about 07:00 A.M. Thereafter I searched everywhere in the place of possibility of his presence but all were in vain and ultimately I informed the matter in writing to your police station on 18.02.2019 being NJP P.S. G.D.E. No. 942/2019 dated on 18.02.2019.

I would like to further inform you that on 09.02.2026 my daughter-in-law along with her parents accompanied by some police personnel forcefully entered into my room and informed me by the said police personnel that my daughter-in-law and her children will stay there and I have to pay a sum of Rs. 10,000/- per month and due to such sudden unwanted situation I became shocked however after leaving of the said police personnel my daughter-in-law and her parents started to abuse filthy languages to me and my other family members and they became furious and seeing their attitude my other family members left my place for avoiding any complication and in the meantime my daughter-in-law and her father started to demand money as because they have huge money for litigation and I tried to convince that I am retired person and most of my pension amount are used for my treatment and I am unable to pay any further and thereafter my daughter-in-law and her father forcibly opened the showcase and her father taken a sum of Rs. 8,000/- from there and during the protest they assaulted me by fist and blow and pulled my hair and for that I fell down on the earth and I sustained injury and thereafter I have to brought to Railway Hospital at about 8:45 P.M. and they have most illegally occupied my said place and I am very

much apprehended that they may cause serious injury to me and my family members for grabbing the properties of my sons'.

It is pertinent to mention that after this incident I was unable to lodge this written complaint due to my medical admission and treatment for which I lodged this complaint on 11.02.2026 with my one of the daughter-in-law, namely Pramila Singh before the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, District - Darjeeling, requesting to investigate the matter and do needful.

I would like to inform you that after the lodging of the said complaint before the Commissioner of Police, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, by my one of the daughter-in-law namely Pramila Singh, said Pramila Singh received a call on 15.03.2026, at about 11:00 A.M. from one of the Officer of the N.J.P. Police Station regarding the incident of the case along with other documents for its perusal. That on 17.03.2026 at about 03:30 P.M. I along with my one of the daughter-in-law Pramila Singh visited the officer at the concerned police station and after careful examination of all the documents the concerned officer requested to lodge the complaint afresh before the concerned N.J.P. Police Station, keeping the request of the Inquiry Officer as appointed by the Commissioner of Police of Siliguri Police Commissionerate I am lodging this complaint afresh.

So in the view of the above circumstances I would like to request you to investigate the matter and do needful for the ends of justice.
