Subject: Complaint against my husband Sri Bapi Sarkar for cruelty, domestic violence, and life threat.

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Smt. Sandipa Sarkar, wife of Sri Bapi Sarkar, presently residing at Deshbandupara, District Darjeeling, PIN - 734004, permanent resident of Pankaj Ray Sarani, Deshbandupara, Siliguri, District Darjeeling, PIN - 734004, respectfully submit this complaint for your kind consideration.

I would like to state that I was married to my husband on 22.11.2003 according to Hindu rites and customs. During the first year of our marriage, everything was normal and peaceful between us. However, gradually the situation started to deteriorate. Later on, I came to know that my husband was a regular consumer of alcohol and most important point is that whenever he consumed alcohol, he used to physically assault and beat me brutally for any such reason. Despite of such treatment, I tolerated everything for the sake of saving my marriage. Thereafter such witness my in-laws advised me to have a child so that my husband might become more responsible and change his behaviour for the sake of our child, but unfortunately nothing was changed again at night he used to come home drunk and beat me brutally in front our little daughter for his enjoyment.

It is further submitted that my husband has a persistent habit of stealing money in order to consume alcohol. In addition to this, he has developed a serious habit of gambling. On several occasions, he has stolen money from both my locker as well as the locker of my in-laws and has spent the same on gambling, alcohol, and visiting call girls.

Whenever I confronted him regarding these acts, he would become extremely violent and brutally assault me, also started to assault me verbally by stating that "magi kothakar haramzadi ja bolbo chup chap sunbi noile mere felbo, khanaki kotha kar ekta, kar kar sathe chude asis k jane" During such incidents he would threaten me in abusive language, stating words to the effect that if I interfered too much, he would kill me and my daughter.

Further, on several occasions when he was intoxicated, he would forcefully demand sexual relations. Even when I clearly refused, he would forcibly establish physical relations with me against my will for his own satisfaction. These acts caused me severe physical and mental trauma and humiliation.

Due to his excessive consumption of alcohol and gambling habits, both I and my in-laws became extremely worried about his behaviour. Therefore, we decided to

seek medical advice. After consulting a doctor, it was advised that my husband should be admitted to a rehabilitation centre for proper treatment and recovery.

Accordingly, in the year 2016 as per the doctor's advice, we admitted my husband to **MOSK Foundation (Rehabilitation Centre)** situated at Junction, Pradhananagar, Siliguri for treatment. He remained there for approximately three months. However, after returning from the rehabilitation centre, there was no improvement in his behaviour and everything continued as before. He again started consuming alcohol excessively, using abusive language without any reason, and physically assaulting me. He also started beating both me and my daughter without any justification. This behaviour caused immense physical and mental torture to both of us.

Thereafter, again in the year 2023, my husband was admitted to **Sunrise Foundation, a rehabilitation centre situated at Bhabesh More**, for further treatment of his alcohol addiction. He remained there for approximately two and a half months. However, even after returning from the rehabilitation centre, no improvement in his behaviour was observed and for the third time in the year 2025 he again admitted to sunrise foundation but no positive result was provided from there.

That after the death of my mother-in-law in the month of May 2025, my husband's torture towards me and my daughter became even more excessive and unbearable. So at last for the sake of me and my daughter's life, I approached the Councillor of Ward No. 30 and complained about the matter. At that time, my in-laws assured the councillor that such incidents would not occur again and those we would live peacefully but unfortunately after few days again, due to some trivial reason, he brutally assaulted me and even attempted to kill both me and my daughter by choking our necks.

Finally, having no other option left and fearing for the safety of my life and my daughter's life, I was compelled to leave my matrimonial home on 08.03.2026 in order to protect ourselves from further physical and mental harm. It is necessary to mention here that even after leaving my matrimonial home I have been constantly living under fear and threat. My husband has repeatedly visited my rented residence and threatened me in front of others, stating that he would kill us if I did not return to my matrimonial home.

Therefore, I humbly request you to kindly take appropriate legal action against my husband for the continuous physical and mental torture inflicted upon me and my daughter and provide us with necessary protection and justice.
