Subject: Complaint against Hub In-Charge Dipak Ghosh of Shadowfax Technologies Ltd for misappropriation of company cash and non-payment despite agreement dated 09.01.2026

Dear Sir,

I, Ranjit Deb, S/O Rathin Deb, mobile number 9830546393, residing at 65B, Mahanirban Road, Kolkata – 700029, P.S. Rabindra Sarobar, am working as a Security Manager with Shadowfax Technologies Ltd, having its branch office at Gosainpur, Bagdogra, Darjeeling, West Bengal – 734014 (opposite Milani Club).

Shadowfax Technologies Ltd is engaged in the business of providing delivery and pickup services to its clients.

I would like to bring to your kind notice that Mr. Dipak Ghosh (Emp ID: SF12809), S/O Dulal Ghosh, holding Aadhaar No. 5326 6470 9716, residing at Gosainpur, Lalmon-Jote, Bhujia Bani, Bagdogra, Darjeeling, West Bengal – 734014, and having mobile number 9732252193, was working as the Hub In-Charge at our above-mentioned office. He was responsible for handling daily cash collection and its deposit.

It has been found that he has not deposited company cash amounting to Rs. 2,21,561/- during the month of December 2025. During a meeting with Dipak Ghosh on 21st Dec, 2025, he agreed to pay back a sum of Rs. 2,20,000/- out of Rs. 2,21,561/- to Shadowfax Technologies Ltd. However, he subsequently stopped responding to calls and did not repay any amount. A subsequent meeting was held on the 8th of Jan, 2026 wherein he agreed to pay a revised amount of Rs. 1,91,000/- as full and final settlement to Shadowfax Technologies Ltd. Following this, a formal agreement was executed with him on 9th of January 2026, wherein he agreed to deposit Rs. 1,91,000/- in three instalments. The first instalment was due on 10th February 2026, with the second and third instalments to be paid at intervals of 30 days each from the date of the first payment.

However, despite the agreement, he has failed to pay any instalment to date.

In view of the above, we request your kind intervention in this matter and necessary action against the said individual for misappropriation of company funds and breach of agreement.
